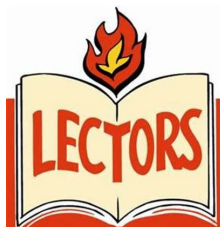
**OCIA for Adults:**

Friday, Nov. 1st is the Feast of All Saints and is a Holy Day of Obligation. There will be a Vigil Mass on Thursday, Oct. 31st at 7:00 p.m. On Friday, there will be our regular 8:30 a.m. Mass and a tri-lingual Mass at 7:00 p.m. that evening.



### Saint of the Week: Saint Frumentius of Axum

Saint Frumentius of Axum, often called the "Apostle of Ethiopia," was instrumental in the Christianization of the Ethiopian Empire in the 4th century. Originally from Tyre (modern-day Lebanon), Frumentius and his brother, Aedesius, were captured during a voyage and taken as slaves to the Ethiopian royal court. Over time, they earned the trust of the king, who granted them important positions. After the king's death, Frumentius became a key advisor to the queen and helped raise the young prince. He used his influence to introduce and promote Christianity, establishing a Christian presence in the kingdom.

Frumentius later traveled to Alexandria, where he sought support for the Christian community in Ethiopia. He was consecrated as the first Bishop of Axum by Saint Athanasius of Alexandria, which marked the official establishment of the Ethiopian Church. His work led to Ethiopia becoming one of the earliest Christian nations. Frumentius is venerated as a saint, especially in the Eastern Orthodox and Ethiopian Orthodox Churches, for his evangelizing efforts and his role in nurturing one of the world's oldest Christian communities. His feast day is celebrated on October 27th, and he is honored as the patron saint of Ethiopia for his pioneering missionary work.
