Saint of the Week

Saint Apollonia

Saint Apollonia was a 3rd-century Christian martyr from Alexandria, Egypt, known as the patron saint of dentists and those suffering from toothaches. She was born in the 2nd century. She was taught by her mother about Jesus Christ and Christianity at an early age. When she was older, she developed a strong desire to be baptized and serve God. An angel appeared and led her out of Alexandria into the desert to the cell of Leonine, a disciple of Saint Anthony. During a violent anti-Christian uprising led by Emperor Phillip, she was captured and tortured for her faith. Her torture included having all of her teeth violently pulled out or shattered. She was threatened with being burned alive unless she renounced Christianity. Apollonia courageously chose to leap into the flames rather than betray her faith.

St. Apollonia died in the year 249. Her unwavering devotion made her a symbol of strength and faithfulness in the face of persecution. Saint Apollonia's feast day is celebrated on **February 9th**, and she is often depicted holding a pair of pincers with a tooth as a reminder of her suffering and victory through faith. In some parts of Europe, Catholics believe that fasting and prayer on the day of St. Apollonia's feast day celebration guarantees a toothache-free year.
