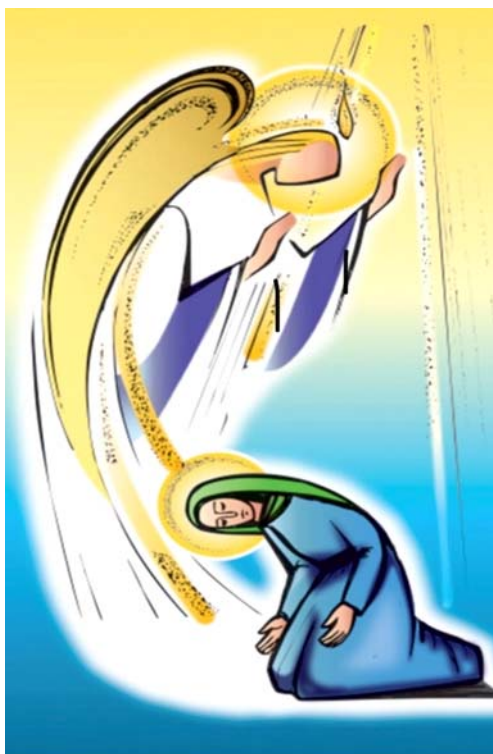

Saint of the Week: St. Justin Martyr

Saint Justin Martyr (c. 100 – c. 165 AD) was an early Christian philosopher, apologist, and one of the most significant figures among the early Church Fathers. Born in Flavia Neapolis (modern-day Nablus), he was raised in a pagan family and studied various schools of Greek philosophy, including Stoicism and Platonism, in his quest for truth. He eventually encountered Christianity, which he believed to be the ultimate and true philosophy.

After his conversion, Justin became a passionate defender of the Christian faith. He traveled and taught, eventually settling in Rome, where he opened a school of Christian philosophy. His most famous works—First Apology, Second Apology, and Dialogue with Trypho—respond to pagan criticisms and provide a rational defense of Christianity. In these writings, Justin argued that Christianity was the fulfillment of both Jewish prophecy and Greek philosophical wisdom. He also described early Christian practices and beliefs, making his work invaluable for understanding the early Church.

Justin was arrested and executed in Rome under the reign of Emperor Marcus Aurelius for refusing to renounce his faith. He was beheaded along with several of his students, and is honored as a martyr for his unwavering commitment to Christ. The Catholic Church celebrates his feast day on June 1.
