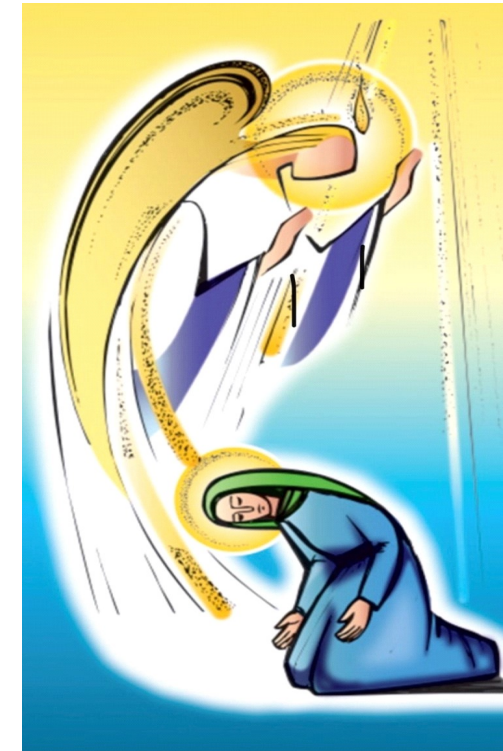

Born in Saigon, Vietnam as the tenth child in a big family of 11 children, Charles was quiet, timid, and tended to stay away from attention. He was among the last for attention, and observed and listened more than he spoke, and rarely shared his thoughts. Below is an excerpt from his biography.

“In my past 20 years of serving as a catechist, prayer group leader, religious education coordinator, retreat guide, Vietnamese community representative, and most recently, Annunciation Parish Council member, I have grown in patience and understanding, in courage and humility working with others. I have come to realize more that ever, even though there are things that I could not understand yet, I should trust in the Lord; that I need not run before grace, but to let go and let God be in charge. I have also learned that I could not do anything without Him, and only in prayers, can I be strengthened in mind and spirit to serve the Lord faithfully”.

Saint of the Week: St. Medard of Noyon



Son of Nectadus, a Frankish noble, and Protagia, Gallo-Roman nobility. Medardus often accompanied his father on business to Vermand, France and to Tournai, Belgium, and frequented the schools there. He was ordained at age 33.

A reluctant bishop of Vermand in 530; in 531, he moved his see to Noyon, France, which was further from border clashes. Bishop of Tournai in 532; the union of the two dioceses lasted until 1146. Gave the veil to Queen Saint Radegunde. Medardus was one of the most honored bishops of his time, his memory has always been venerated in northern France, and he soon became the hero of numerous legends.

Legend says that when he was a child, Medard was once sheltered from the rain by a hovering eagle. This is his most common depiction in art, and led to his patronage of good weather, against bad weather, for people who work the fields, etc. Legend has it that if it rains on his feast day, the next 40 days will be wet; if the weather is good, the next 40 will be fine as well. He was also depicted as laughing aloud with his mouth wide open; this led to his patronage against toothache.

On 8 June 545 at Noyon, France St. Medard died of natural causes.
