Besides being an awesomely fun and entertaining day for the students as they get a chance to run outside for an extra hour, the **Dash for Cash** is a fundraiser for PJPII. Recently they had the chance to exercise their brains with the Read-A-Thon, now they have the chance to exercise their bodies while raising funds!

The **Dash for Cash** event day is a high energy, fun, and exciting outdoor activity! The soccer field is transformed into a track upon which the students "dash" to complete as many laps as they can! Each student is dressed in their **Dash for Cash** t-shirt and has their Dashing bib on to record their lap tally! During their scheduled time, each class will "dash" around the track with their classmates and a few other classes, all while enjoying great music, snacks, friendship, and fresh air!

Another fundraiser? Yep, the funds raised with **Dash for Cash** are rolled back into the general operating budget to assist with offsetting the needs for curriculum, basic supplies, STEAM, gym equipment, general building, campus, and equipment upgrades, etc. PJPII's school building is almost 20 years old and keeping it looking as fresh and fabulous as the day it opened is no small feat. PJPII's 620+ students pray hard, learn hard, and play hard in this building, so there are constant upgrades and repairs, along with preventative maintenance done every year (painting, floors, etc.). Tuition only covers **84%** of the cost to educate our students. By investing in PJPII, you are supporting our mission of providing a high-quality, Catholic education rooted in faith and tradition while keeping that Catholic education affordable for families.
