Since the celebrations of the Sacraments are not mere family or social occasions, but celebrations of

faith for active believers, those who seek to have their children baptized or to serve as sponsors (godparents) for Baptism or for Confirmation, as well as those preparing for Marriage, must demonstrate that they are faithful, practicing

Catholics who have been registered & attending Mass regularly at the parish for at least three months, and who are leading lives of faith.

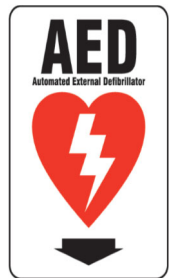
