The Paschal Triduum

THE TRIDUUM is to the whole of the liturgical year what Sunday is to the week: it is a holy period—indeed the holiest period—and makes present, in a real and temporal way, the mystery of Jesus' passion and death before His glorious resurrection.

It is the period of three days that begins with the liturgy on the evening of Maundy Thursday, reaches its greatest height in the Easter Vigil, and closes with evening prayer on Easter Sunday. It is not merely a sequence of days, but is itself a prayer of final preparation wherein we enter into the redemption of humanity and the salvation of the world made present in the Resurrection of our Lord.

On these days we are able to walk with our God in the real passage of time, to remember the hour of His Last Supper, His Agony, to witness the Scourging and Crowning with thorns, to follow the Stations of the Cross to the summit of Golgotha on which He was crucified, to stand in sorrow and mourning with His Mother at His death, to go with Him to the tomb, and thereafter grieve His going away from this world, His absence from the tabernacles, in bereaved silence—all over a period of days, and all so that we might more perfectly participate in the magnificent joy of His Resurrection, when He is returned to us as victor over the jaws of death.

That horror which punished Adam—death—is made the means of our greatest joy; but it still is a horror, being a product of sin, inflicted upon One who could never deserve it, and therefore worthy of great remorse and sorrow, for it is our iniquity that has caused it.

Let us enter prayerfully into the coming Holy Week in preparation for Christ's rising from the dead. Let His Passion prepare us, also, for the inescapable suffering in our own lives, that we might always unite it to that of He who perished for our salvation, and thereby obtain some piece of the glory of His Resurrection in the eternity that follows.
