# Jesus, the Bread of Life

This week we continue reflecting on the Eucharist. The Eucharist, at the heart of our worship, is first and foremost about a Divine Person: The Lord Jesus Christ. WE encounter a person when we receive the eucharist. We come into intimacy with a Divine person. So, when approaching the Eucharist at mass, I often have thought that it is like Moses approaching the burning bush. He approached the burning bush as approaching a Divine person who was revealing himself to Moses. Moses heard the word of God through this encounter with a holy God. In addition, coming to the eucharist as if we were approaching a "burning bush" is approaching a holy Divine person - God who calls to us and invites to himself. This is what Moses experienced. We approach the Son of God glorified in his humanity. He is the sacrificial Lamb who is offered up for our sins. Our encounter is one that is rooted in a divine outpouring of love. Coming to the altar sacrifice is about coming to the burning heart of God's love for us through Jesus, the bread of life.

Considering this, we call Jesus the bread of life. He is the outpouring of love that forgives our sins and heals the wound of sin in our hearts. To eat and drink of his body and blood in faith is to receive this love and yield to its power to heal our hearts. Eucharistic revival begins with how we approach the altar of sacrifice and how we approach the One who has given all for our freedom.


