



WHAT IS A CONCLAVE?

The Cardinals in Rome announced that the conclave will begin on Wednesday, May 7, to elect a new pope. The word "conclave" means "locked with a key," because the Cardinals are sequestered inside the Vatican until they elect a new Holy Father.

PRAYING FOR THE CARDINALS ELECTING A NEW POPE

To support the Cardinals – and to pray for the man they will elect as pope – we began a novena this week at St. Stephen's. We will pray this novena at every public Mass (after Holy Communion) until it concludes on the first day of the conclave. I invite you to join us in praying for the election of a holy pope over the coming days.

On May 7, the 135 "Cardinal-Electors" will gather in the Sistine Chapel to elect a new pope. On the first day, there is one vote. There are four votes on each of the following days, until a ½ majority is reached. White smoke signals a new pope.
