
of Father Seelos.


#### JUNE: MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART

#### The Story of the Sacred Heart Devotion:

In 1674, a nun named Sister Margaret Mary received special visions and messages from Christ. One day, while in adoration before the Blessed Sacrament, Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary. She saw Him coming towards her, with his left hand pointing at her .and with his right hand pointing to his Heart, exposed.

The Heart of Christ that this nun saw had a crown of thorns on it and a fire - "a Furnace of Fire" - coming from the top. Looking at Sister Margaret Mary and also pointing to His Sacred Heart, Jesus spoke these words:

"THIS is the Heart which has loved men, so very much, but which has received so little love in return..."

#### KEEPING YOU INFORMED: THE RECTORY PROJECT (2<sup>ND</sup> NOTICE)

On Thursday, June 19, I met with our architect and his team in Baton Rouge. The architect has completed preliminary drawings to submit to the diocese for approval. On August 10<sup>th</sup>, I will go before the Diocesan Building Review Board and defend this proposal. This is an additional step required for all new constructions in the diocese. Once we receive their approval, our architect will be able to begin planning work with a contractor. This phase of the construction-planning process is always slow-going.
