

Are you or someone you know interested in joining the Catholic Church?


Are you interested in completing your Sacraments of Initiation (First Communion, First Confession, Confirmation)?

LIVING OUR CATHOLIC FAITH: FAITH & PATRIOTISM

Fulton Sheen speaks about what it truly means to be an American – the intersection of Faith and Patriotism:

In a 1955 telecast, Sheen said, "Jefferson set down in the second paragraph of the Declaration of Independence that the Creator has endowed man with certain unalienable rights. Meaning, rights that cannot be taken away - among which are the right to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. That is our democracy. It is based on the recognition of God-given gifts."

"See, our county has theological foundations! In other words, our Declaration of Independence is a declaration of dependence. We are independent because we are dependent on God. If we wish to keep our rights and liberties, we must also keep our God! Piety and patriotism go together. That is the first glory of being an American."

KEEPING YOU INFORMED: THE RECTORY PROJECT (3RD NOTICE)

On Thursday, June 19, I met with our architect and his team in Baton Rouge. The architect has completed preliminary drawings to submit to the diocese for approval. On August 10th, I will go before the Diocesan Building Review Board and defend this proposal. This is an additional step required for all new constructions in the diocese. Once we receive their approval, our architect will be able to begin planning work with a contractor. This phase of the construction-planning process is always slow-going. But know that progress is being made each week. I will continue to keep you updated, and let you know when we have a timeline for work. - Fr. Istre
