



INTRODUCING THEOLOGY IN A BOTTLE

Join us for evenings of faith, discussion, and good wine.

Each "Theology in a Bottle" evening is a social gathering where we welcome a different speaker to share their unique knowledge on a particular aspect of our Catholic Faith.

What is the format?

Each evening begins with wine and conversation, followed by a 10-20 minute talk and open discussion. "Theology in a Bottle" lasts just over an hour.

Space is limited - How do I register?

INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC?
