Despair and grief are part of the human condition, and are often brought on because of loss or suffering. In Christ, however, we experience hope and healing. As disciples working to build the kingdom of God on earth, let us, like Saint Paul, willingly take the Gospel to others and share our hope freely with them.

LITURGY OF THE WORD:

Job expresses his despair, describing life without hope or happiness. Saint Paul writes that he has no reason to boast – that preaching the Gospel is an obligation. Thus, he offers the Gospel free of charge and has become all things to all, to save at least some. In the Gospel, Jesus touches and cures Simon's mother-in-law, as well as many others, throughout the whole of Galilee.
