Annual Report - 2021

I am pleased to provide you with our 2021 Full Year's Report from the <u>Disch</u> <u>DeClouet</u> Social Service Center....45 years of service to Iberia Parish.

- We are pleased to report that without interruption (COVID), we were able to continue providing assistance with Utility Bills, Rent, Emergency Housing, Medications. Dental Assistance, Employment Assistance and Transportation, as well as providing our Clients with Food and Clothing.
- 2. We are open Monday Thursday at 800AM. We provide services to approximately 400 families per month (approximately 1400 individuals). Our Milk Fund partnership with The Daily Iberian assists is in providing milk to 25 families with children per month. We provide about 150 gallons of milk per month.
- Contributions from our supporters continued to allow our Center to accomplish its Mission. Contributions in 2021 enabled us to not only provide much needed assistance to those in need, but to meet our financial obligations and to maintain our facilities.
- 4. We continue to be a 100% Volunteer Staff. This allows us to maximize assisting our clients with the financial donations that we are blessed to receive.
- 5. Our Center is blessed not only with Financial Donations from our community but donations of Clothing and Household goods. We have a full line of clothing for our clients to choose from. It should be noted that ALL food and clothing donations to our Center are distributed at no cost to our clients. It should be noted that this past Holiday Season the Center was particularly blessed with extra donations of food, clothing and gifts for our clients with children.
- While many of our clients accessed our services throughout the year, we also witnessed a significant number of clients seeking assistance for the first time. Many clients came to seek help that have not done so for many years.
- Through direct referrals we were able to make possible for quite a few needy families to be "adopted" this past Christmas.
- Anyone wishing to donate to our Center (financially, food, clothing, etc.) we are available from 800AM to 10AMM M-Th to accept donations.

We ask for your continued prayers and support as we work diligently to support the less fortunate of our community.


