

Ist Quarter Report - 2023

I am pleased to provide you with our 1st Quarter Report for the year 2023 from the Disch-DeClouet Social Service Center....47 years of service to Iberia Parish.

ANNUAL CAMPAIGN — The Center's Annual Campaign kicked off at the beginning of the Lent. Donations continue to be received. This year's campaign has proven to be a great success. The people of our parish are so generous and we are blessed. Thanks again to our campaign coordinator, Melissa Dworaczyk.

CLIENTS – We continue to operate at capacity.....25 clients per day (400 per month). This calculates to about 1300 people served per month. On a regular basis we remind our clients that we can only assist them because of the generosity of our local supporters. We pray for their petitions as well as for our Center's supporters.

DONATIONS – So many schools, organizations, prayer groups and individuals have given support to our Center this past quarter. These donations allowed us to provide all seeking assistance to have the warm clothing, coats and blankets that they needed. This past quarter we were particularly blessed with food donations from Catholic High and St. Edward S. A reminder that we do not charge for any items that we distribute......as they are given to us.

OPERATIONS: The Center is open Monday – Thursday. We open our doors at 8:00AM and serve the I" 25 clients in line. We are usually at the building to accept donations until 10AM. If you wish to make a donation please contact the Center and your call will be returned.

VOLUNTEERS – We are all Volunteers offering our time and talents to serve the poor and needy of Iberia Parish. Should you have any interest in serving as a volunteer please contact myself or our office.






