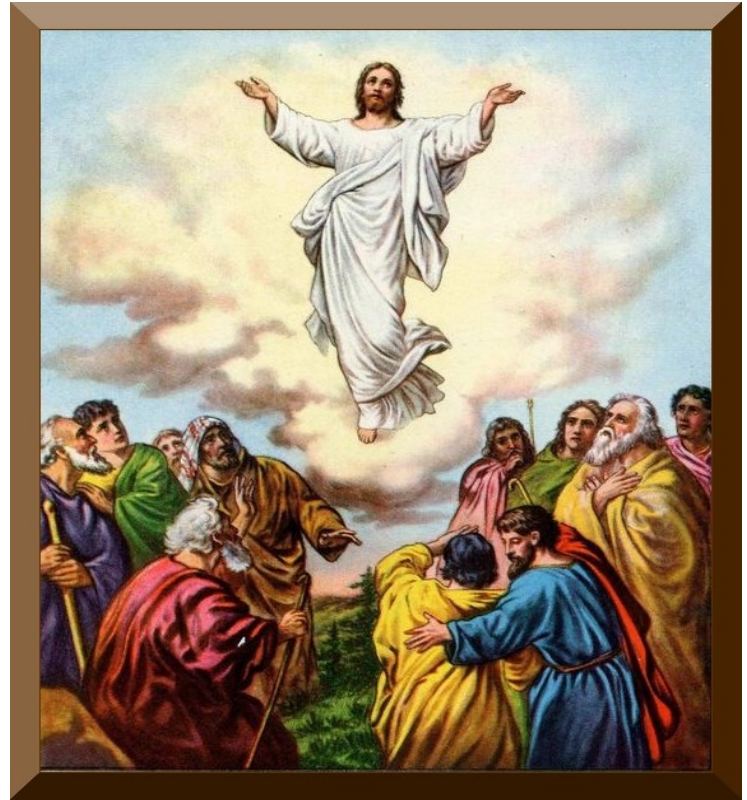

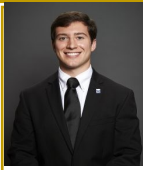

Commencing at Sacred Heart Church in Prairie Ronde for noon Mass and Family Picnic. (Invite your family to meet you there!)

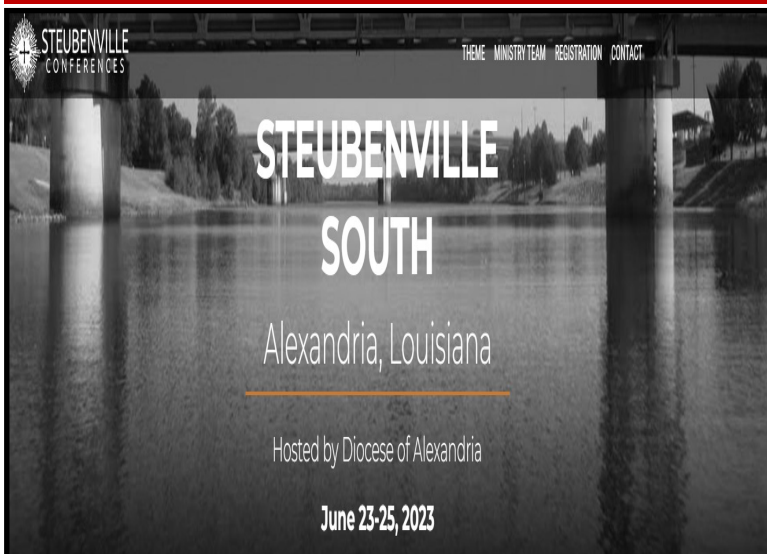
