



2nd Ouarter Report - 2023

I am pleased to provide you with our 2nd Quarter Report for the year 2023 from the Disch-DeClouet Social Service Center....47 years of service to Iberia. Parish.

PROPERTY: The property where we operate is actually 4 separate buildings. While the property is leased from St. Peter's, we are charged with all maintenance and improvements. We have recently made a number of repairs to our facilities which have proven to be quite expensive. This unfortunately drains some of the money that is targeted for financial support of our clients. Thank you for your support!

CLIENTS – We continue to operate at capacity.....25 clients per day (400 per month). This calculates to about 1300 people served per month. On a regular basis we remind our clients that we can only assist them because of the generosity of our local supporters. We pray for their petitions as well as for our Center's supporters.

DONATIONS – Our Center continues to be blessed by the financial support of our Community. We had an excellent Annual Campaign. Our food supplies have been running low. We have recently purchased rice and beans to make certain that our clients are cared for. We maintain a large clothing department and donations of this nature are always welcomed. A reminder that we do not charge for any items that we distribute.....as they are given to us.

OPERATIONS: The Center is open Monday – Thursday. We open our doors at 8:00AM and serve the 1" 25 clients in line. We are usually at the building to accept donations until 10AM. If you wish to make a donation please contact the Center and your call will be returned.

VOLUNTEERS – We are all Volunteers offering our time and talents to serve the poor and needy of Iberia Parish. Should you have any interest in serving as a volunteer please contact myself or our office.

Needs: Non-Perishable food, clothing (especially men's shoes), bed linens, blankets and diapers (adult and children).






