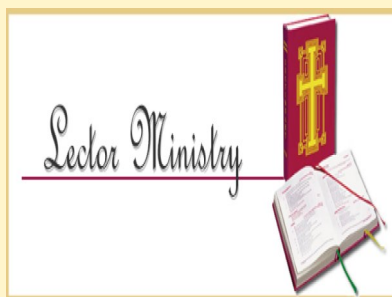


2023 Fall Fun Fest LAS Raffle
