

End of Year Report - 2023

I am pleased to provide you with our End of the Year Report from the Disch-DeClouet Social Service Center....47 years of service to Iberia Parish

PROPERTY: The property where we operate is actually 4 separate buildings. The facilities from which we operate are leased from St. Peter Catholic Church. However, we have responsibility for repairs and maintenance. Some of our larger repairs have been to the building at 428 Bank St (sewage, electrical and AC/Heating), on-going maintenance of the AC/Heating System at 430 and 432 Bank Ave and needed repairs to our folding door in our warehouse.

CLIENTS – We continue to operate at capacity.....25 clients per day (400 per month). This calculates to about 1300 people served per month. On a regular basis we remind our clients that we can only assist them because of the generosity of our local supporters. We pray for their petitions as well as for our Center's supporters. During this past Thanksgiving and Christmas holiday season we were able to "connect" several needy families with generous donors that provided holiday meals and gifts. We continue to serve our regular clients but are seeing an increasing number of clients from many years past and also new clients. In addition our Center is a major source of support for the Homeless Shelter.

DONATIONS – Our Center continues to be blessed by the financial support of our Community. At the end of 2023 and entering into 2024 we have a large inventory of food and clothes that will greatly benefit those in need. During the holidays our Center was blessed with donations from many organizations, schools and individuals.

OPERATIONS: The Center is open Monday – Thursday. We open our doors at 8:00AM and serve the 1st 25 clients in line. We are usually at the building to accept donations until 10AM. If you wish to make a donation please contact the Center and your call will be returned.

VOLUNTEERS – We are all Volunteers offering our time and talents to serve the poor and needy of Iberia Parish. Should you have any interest in serving as a volunteer please contact myself or our office.

Needs: Non-Perishable food, clothing (especially men's shoes), bed linens, coats, blankets and **diapers** (adult and children).

Our Volunteers Staff cannot thank you enough for the continued support that you have given to our Center. 2024 will mark the 48" year of continuous service to our Community. Our ability to continue serving the needs of those less fortunate is based solely on your generosity.
