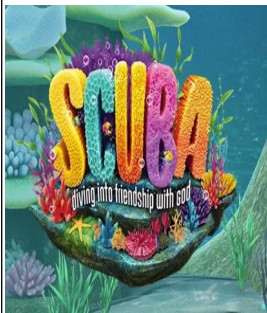

HOLY THURSDAY



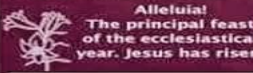
Celebrates the Last Supper with the disciples and Passover.
