2024 End of the Year Report

As we near the conclusion of our 48th year of service to the Community I continue to be amazed by the generosity of the people of Iberia Parish. Your Financial and Material support continues to provide us with the resources to continue our Mission of serving those most in need.

PROPERTY: As a reminder, the Center is located at the corner of Bank and Pershing streets in New Iberia. We have 4 separate buildings on this property. While this provides us space to operate we also must insure and maintain these properties.

CLIENTS: We continue to see 25, and often more, clients per day, Monday – Thursday. This amounts to 400 clients served per month representing approximately 1400 persons in these families. While we have many clients that seek out our services monthly, we also continue to assist new clients at an increasing rate.

SERVICES: Our Center provides assistance with Utility Bills, Rent, non-perishable Food, Licenses / ID's (needed for work), work clothes/shoes, Clothing for all seasons (women's - men's - children's - infants - school clothes), Bedding items, Kitchen and Bath materials, Books, Diapers and Wipes (adult and infant), personal need packets for the homeless, Milk vouchers and Emergency Housing for women and their families via our partnership with the Homeless Shelter of Iberia.

DONATIONS: Our overhead expenses remain minimal. Our greatest expenses revolve around Building maintenance and Insurance, normal operating expenses (utilities, phone, waste service and accounting). We are all Volunteers - there are no salary expenses. We do not receive funding from any government sources. All of the monies that we receive come from individuals and foundations in our community and local churches.

As we enter into our 49th year we humbly ask for your continued support and prayers. God continues to bless us!
