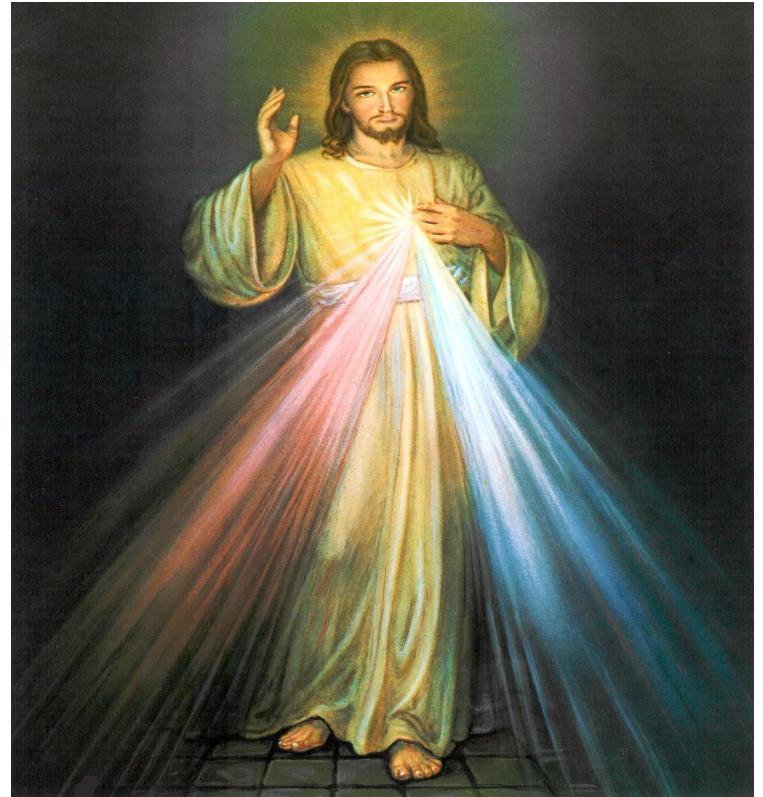

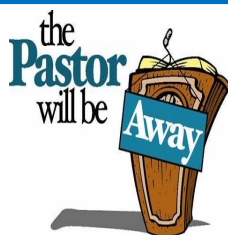


NO WEEKDAY MASSES
