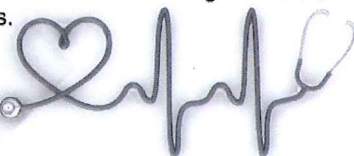

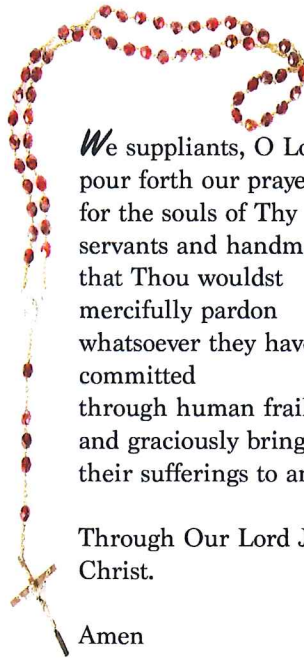

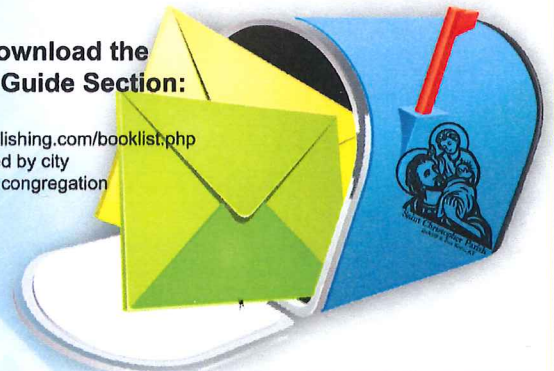

A second time he sent other servants, saying,
'Tell those invited: "Behold, I have prepared my banquet,

went away, one to his farm, another to his business.
The rest laid hold of his servants, mistreated them, and killed
them. The king was enraged and sent his troops, destroyed

not worthy to come. Go out, therefore, into the main roads and

into the streets and gathered all they found, bad and good
