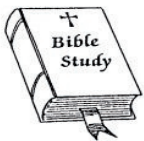
Faith Formation

National Vocation Awareness Week

celebrated November 3-9, 2019, is an annual week-long celebration of the Catholic Church in the United States, dedicated to promoting vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and consecrated life through prayer and

education, and to renew our prayers and support for those who are considering one of these particular vocations. NVAW began in 1976 when the US bishops designated it be held on the 28th Sunday of the year. In 1997, this was moved to coincide with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Beginning in 2014, the celebration was moved to the first full week of November.
