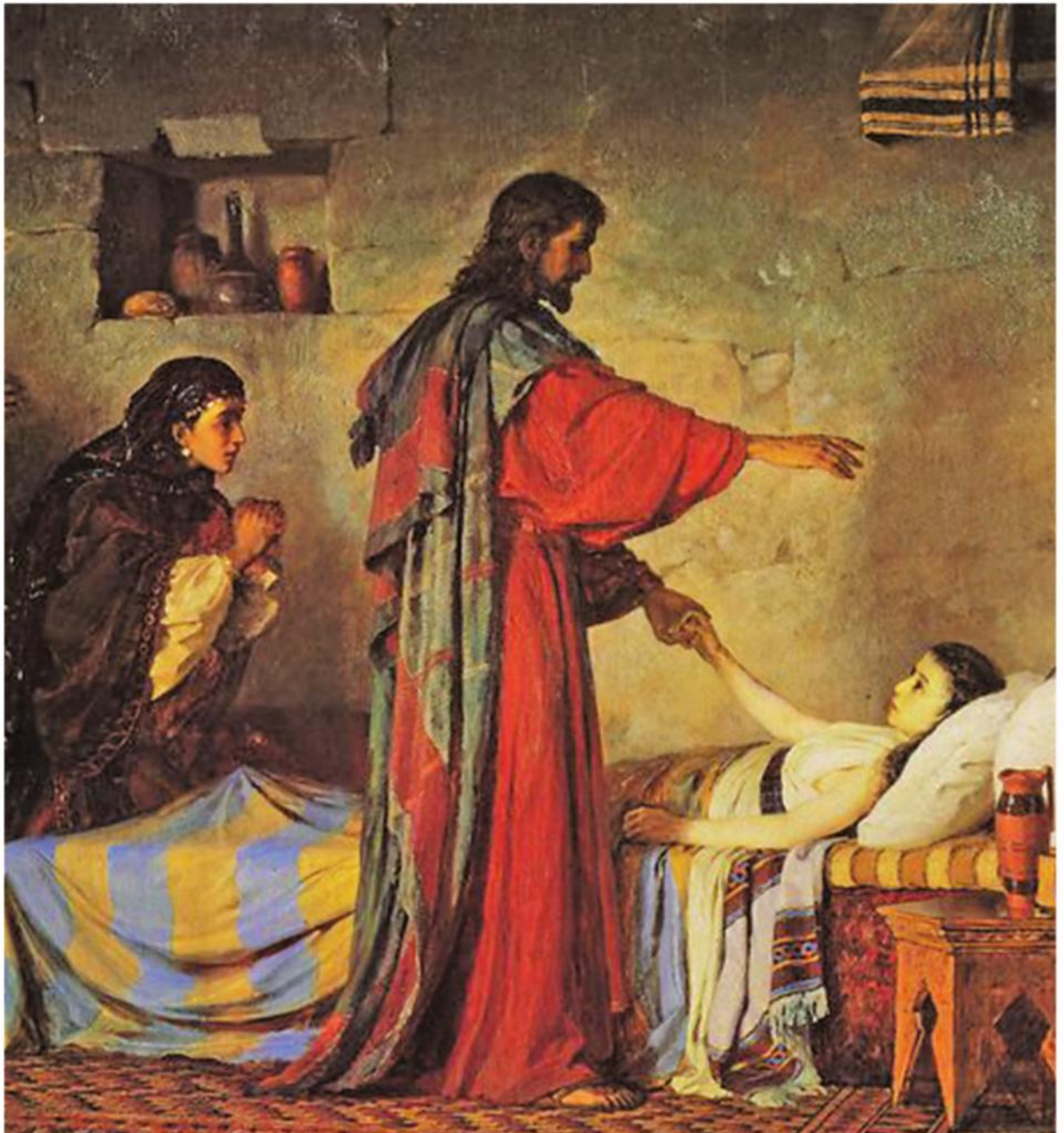

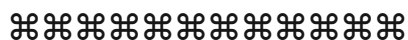


## EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

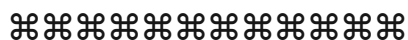
## Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima

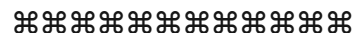

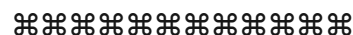
