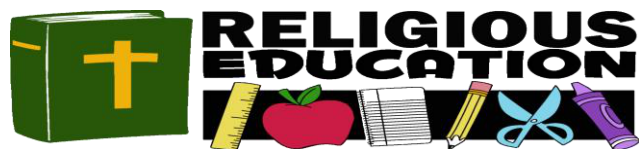

On **November 8th**, Kentuckians will go to the polls once again. One of the choices facing them this year are two proposed amendments to our State Constitution. The second of these is of paramount importance, as it will explicitly affirm that the Kentucky Constitution contains no right to either abortion or its governmental funding.

The Kentucky Catholic Bishops are therefore strongly encouraging all Kentuckians to go to the polls on election day this year, **turn over their ballots and vote 'YES' for Amendment #2 which is located at the very bottom of the back page. 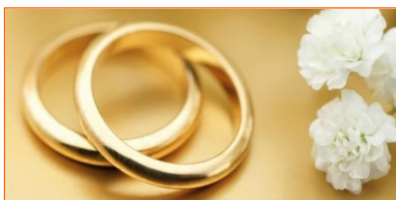


On October 21/22 (Friday-Saturday), from 6 pm to approx.
