


EUCHARISTIC ADORATION



RCIA – the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults -- Where do you feel a strong presence of God? Maybe you would think of a forest, a mountain, the ocean, or perhaps

your childhood home. Catholics encounter God in many places but Pope Paul VI in Christus Dominus says there are places Catholics believe "exist solely for the good of our souls." One such place is our parish church. This past Tuesday, our candidates learned about the items in our church and every Catholic Church that help us to encounter God. You can test yourself by describing each item listed, what it is used for, and tell a little history about it: Sanctuary (presbyterium), altar, Roman Missal, candles, ambo, crucifix, tabernacle, sanctuary lamp; narthex, holy water; nave, baptismal font, Easter (Paschal) candle, Stations of the Cross, reconciliation room, ambry, holy oils; sacristy, vestments, alb, cincture, chasuable, dalmatic, stole, amice, chalice, ciborium, paten, cruets, lava bowl. How many could you describe? Think about and pray about being a sponsor for one of the fine folks in the catechumenate - No need to be a theologian, just love of God and man. Sessions meet on Tuesdays, 6-7 pm in the church undercroft. If you need more information, have a question, or you'd like a schedule of the sessions, contact Glory Kramer.
