RCIA – the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults -----This Lent, the combined RCIA classes of St Christopher and St Martin parishes have all baptized candidates. This

means that the rites reserved for the catechumens (non-baptized), such as, the Rite of Election, the Scrutinies, and Presentations will be absent. So, what do the baptized candidates do during Lent? The Rite (Order) says, "They should be eager to renew their own baptismal promises at the Easter Vigil. (9.3, 9.4)" In other words, Lent has the same opportunities for baptized candidates as it does for baptized parishioners. We renew our conversion to Jesus through "penitence, faith and charity." Thus, our candidates participate in Sunday Masses in Lent, the Rite of Penance (confession), penitential practices and devotional prayer, increased personal prayer, increased acts of giving of time, talent, and treasure, weekday liturgy, fasting, especially on the Fridays of Lent, Palm Sunday procession, Stations of the Cross, Adoration, Rosary, nightly examination of conscience, and other practices. Everyone, especially sponsors of the baptized candidates, can help with all of this. Mentor the baptized candidates in getting more deeply involved in the Lenten activities of the parish. Lent has a lot to offer the baptized candidates. Use some of these ideas to provide them with a rich formation process that will renew and deepen their own conversion and will spiritually benefit everyone.



Devotion

St. Martin of Tours, Flaherty, cordially invites the parishioners of Saint Christopher to our *Forty Hours Devotion*, to be held <u>from 1 AM Wednesday</u>, <u>March 22nd</u>, <u>until 7 pm Thursday</u>, <u>March 23</u>. There will be a two-hour pause, from 8-10 AM Thursday for daily Mass. The Forty Hours Devotion is a special 40-hour period of prayer before the exposed Blessed Sacrament made by a community of the faithful. The devotion finds its roots in the 40 hours that Our Lord was in the tomb from 3 PM Good Friday until 6 AM Easter Sunday. The actual Forty Hours Devotion originated in Milan around the year 1530. In the Devotion, we are called to pray for ourselves, and our neighbors. We intercede for the needs of the world before the Lord of Heaven and earth, and we wait upon Him. We adore the Blessed Sacrament "face to Face". We console the Sacred Heart of Our Lord, and enter into spiritual communion with the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.


