The Archdiocese Returns to Distribution of the Precious Blood at Communion



Archbishop Shelton Fabre has announced that the Archdiocese will reinstate permission to distribute the Precious Blood to the faithful from the Chalice at weekend Masses on the Feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and blood of Christ. This year, the feast falls on June 10-11. As always, reception from the Chalice is optional and those who are ill, infirm, or have compromised immune systems should be reassured that our Church also teaches that Jesus Christ is truly and wholly present under both species of bread and wine. In other words, if a person receives only one species, Christ is *fully* present and nothing is lacking. Here, at St. Christopher, we will have a workshop for current ministers and anyone interested in learning more. Watch upcoming bulletins for more details.
