The Archdiocese Returns to Distribution of the Precious Blood at Communion



Archbishop Shelton Fabre has announced that the Archdiocese will reinstate permission to distribute the Precious Blood to the faithful from

the Chalice at weekend Masses on the Feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and blood of Christ. This year, the feast falls on June 10-11. As always, reception from the Chalice is optional and those who are ill, infirm, or have compromised immune systems should be reassured that our Church also teaches that Jesus Christ is truly and wholly present under both species of bread and wine. In other words, if a person receives only one species, Christ is *fully* present and nothing is lacking. Here, at St. Christopher, we will have a workshop for current ministers and anyone interested in learning more. Watch upcoming bulletins for more details.

Important notice from Archdiocese:

Each parish is required to submit records on anyone who works with youth (18 and under). The acknowledgment card from attending a workshop, or the certificate if one attends the refresher course, MUST be on file at the Parish Office. Background checks also must be kept up to date and on file. If you are unsure if your records are current, please call Parish Office to verify. If you have never had the background check, please call to schedule.

ALL employees or volunteers who have contact with children or youth (18 and under) for **ANY** length of time <u>are required to participate</u> in one of the 2-hour Safe Environment Training Workshops.

If you have ever been to a training, you will not need to attend a live session, but will take a very simple refresher course online. Check with Parish Office to see if you are up to date with your training. However, for those who are attending for the first time, the next session will be Monday, May 15, at 6:30 pm at St. James, Elizabethtown, at Batcheldor Hall.

- You must arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the workshop start time listed, in order to complete paperwork. Failure to do so will result in your having to take the class again. Signup sheets will be available – no early registration necessary.
- All registrants must attend/stay the ENTIRE 2-hour presentation, and finish completion paperwork. You will need to bring paperwork back to the Parish Office for the files.
- Important reminder: No one under the age of 18 will be admitted. This includes infants. Also, anyone 18 or older who is in a supervisory role with children MUST have a criminal background check. (Anyone under 18 is not to be given an adult supervisory role of minors.)

If your training and/or background is older than 5 years, contact the Parish Office to receive refresher information. Also, if you cannot attend this upcoming session, but know you will be working with minors, there are two more sessions scheduled in Louisville before the end of summer: May 16th at Holy Spirit, and June 13th at St. Andrew Academy (both at 6:30 pm).

It cannot be stressed enough how important it is to make sure you have the proper paperwork and have it up to date. Thank you.
