Parents work with their children at home solidifying the concepts and doctrine learned in the classroom. Parents, youth, and children make a commitment to regular attendance at all classes and activities. Good attendance makes it possible to grasp religious concepts and to foster a sense of "belonging" to the parish community. Registration is still open. 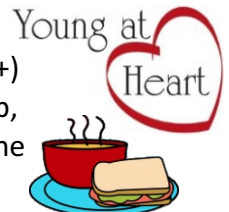
