<u>CCD/Religious Ed</u> –The primary goal of our catechetical program is to assist families in the spiritual formation of their children. This goal is best achieved when there is cooperation and communication between the families and the religious education program.

Good communication between the home and the RE program is important in serving the needs of the children. The teachers and administrators ensure the parents are aware of their children's studies via the Word of Life parent portal and weekly Email messages. Parents work with their children at home solidifying the concepts and doctrine learned in the classroom. Parents, youth, and children make a commitment to regular attendance at all classes and activities. Good attendance makes it possible to grasp religious concepts and to foster a sense of "belonging" to the parish community.




