RCIA – the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults -----

The next session is on **Tuesday, Nov 7 at St Martin, 6-7 pm** when we will talk

about the seven Sacraments of the Church. We will learn how sacraments impart grace, making us holy and building up the Body of Christ, the Church. Sacraments are a way to relate to God through life's transitions and help us to give proper praise and worship to God. They build us in strength, nourish us, and help us to express our faith. Who can participate in the RCIA? The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is geared towards those adults who are not baptized and/or coming from a different faith background. All others who have a desire to learn more about the richness of our Catholic faith are also welcome to participate. Sacraments have the power to bring heaven to earth, rip the veil between all things seen and unseen, and allow humanity and eternity to commingle in mysterious, yet somewhat understandable ways. CCD/Religious Ed – CCD/Religious Ed.

– Parents, youth, and children make a commitment to regular attendance at all classes and activities. Enrollment is encouraged for preschoolers through high schoolers. CCD/RE is not just for those preparing to receive First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation. Good attendance makes it possible to grasp religious concepts and to foster a sense of "belonging" to the parish community. Religious Education helps us to understand our Catholic faith. We know Jesus and Sacred Scripture more deeply. We learn from the wisdom of the saints and other good people. We understand how to celebrate our faith. We grow in our understanding of Church teachings. RE improves our quality of life. Catholic beliefs help us find meaning and purpose. Moral principles give direction. Prayer and liturgy bring us closer to God.

Formal classes help us to explore life's deep questions and helps us to make good choices. Why do good people suffer? What is love? Why be just? What happens after we die? How do know God exists? What is my purpose in life? Why should I care about other people?

Please note, substituting sports or other events for CCD teaches children that these things are more important than their religious formation. 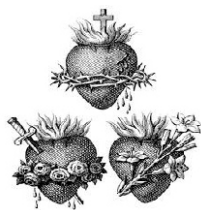

Catholic School Tuition Assistance Applications Are Open for 2024-2025 School Year!

Need-based tuition assistance is available for families attending Catholic schools, and the application portal for the 2024-25 school year is now **open until November 30, 2023**. Go to www.ceflou.org to apply online. Complete only one FACTS application for your family, including all students in the family (elementary and high school) on the same form. You will submit copies of your 2022 tax returns and W2s with the form. FACTS will send a need evaluation to all funding sources for which your family could qualify, as well as the schools you have listed. Note: Even if the high school tuition assistance deadline may be later, it is very important to get this application in by the Nov. 30th date.
