

Feb 6, Deacon Joe Calvert will lead the discussion on the Sacrament of Penance and Tim Curran will lead a discussion on the early Church. The Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation leads us from the sorrow of sin to reconciliation with God and His Church. There is no such thing as a private sin. All sin effects the members of the Church. Thus, when we are absolved in confession, Father forgives in the person of Christ, "in persona Christi," and in the person of the Church, "in persona Ecclesia." Hence, a holy and good confession engenders not only inner peace but peace with the entire people of the Church. The early Church began with Pentecost and the Apostles were commanded to go out and baptize all nations. And indeed, the Apostles accomplished so much in the name of Jesus Christ. As disciples of Christ, we too, inherit the same command. At the conclusion of every Mass, we are commissioned to "go out" and live the Gospel bringing Christ to others in our homes, workplaces, and all activities. 
