LETTING GO ... AND LETTING GOD



When it comes to money or possessions, I know a lot of folks think that Jesus really doesn't understand our complex situation today or he "really didn't mean it like that!" But really, maybe it's the rich young man who went away sad who didn't get it.

Listen carefully to what Jesus says in today's Gospel: He's not saying that money or wealth is BAD. No, Jesus doesn't condemn wealth and possessions as evil in themselves - what is evil is when the pursuit of wealth and riches takes the place of God at the very center of our lives, or when material wealth becomes the focus of our existence: namely, when what we own owns us. Given the choice between the life of God and a life of materialism, the young man seems to choose the latter.

May we possess the faith to center our lives on the things of God, to embrace the "wisdom and prudence" to realize that the things we have are not an end in themselves but the means for living lives of meaning and purpose and re-creating our world in such a way that it reflects the justice and peace of God.

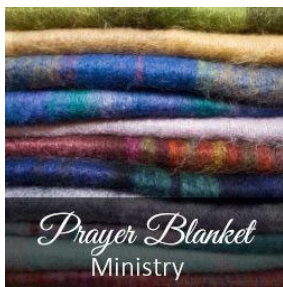

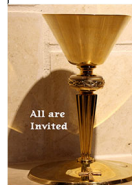

VOCATION CHALICE

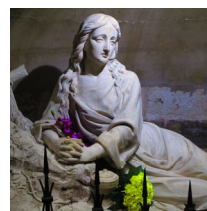


Families host the vocation chalice for one week, praying for Vocations. After a week the chalice is reserved for another family.
