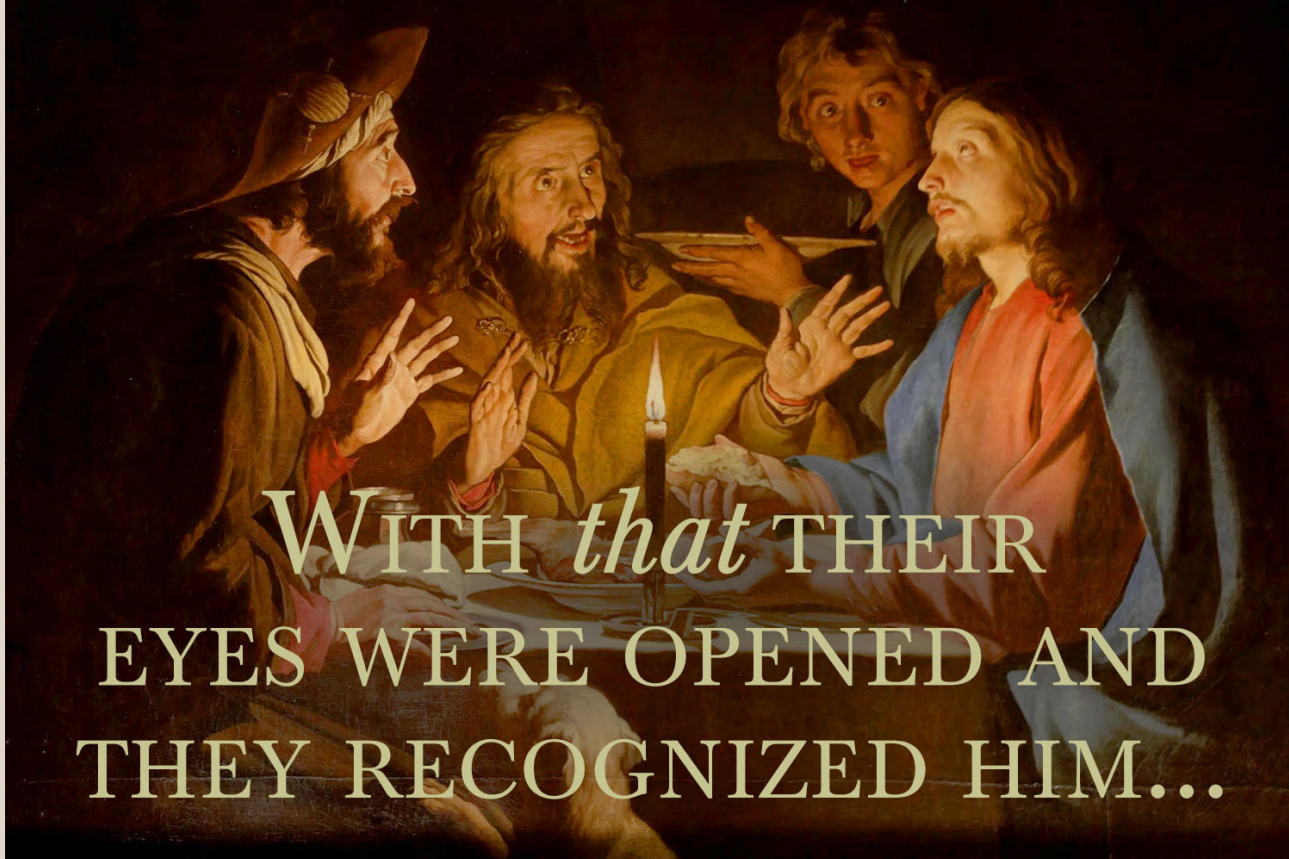

JOURNEY OF A LIFETIME

Those two disciples on the road to Emmaus think they are going back home, but their journey is just beginning. We all take an Emmaus journey more often than we realize, a journey where we experience the Lord's presence as we have numerous encounters and challenges. In fact, a good question that St. Ignatius of Loyola would often ask about any situation is: "Where is the Lord in that?"

Everybody is on a journey, though we don't always recognize it. What kind of journey are you on now? Can you notice any "shift" where your life may be taking you? Have you had more time and space to ponder your important goals in life? Are you moving toward more peace and joy in your life?

He'll take you on the journey of a lifetime!
