FROM THE PASTOR: COMING THIS ADVENT - THE COMMUNION RAIL



Starting on the First Sunday of Advent (Nov 29 - 30), we are going to transition to using the communion rail for all regularly scheduled Masses. To help make this transition as smooth as possible, we have put together a short “explainer” video you can find on our Facebook and our YouTube. It gives a quick look at the reasons for using the communion rail and, especially, the logistics of using the rail. Please take a moment to watch that video. The goal is to get people accustomed to going up to the rail right away rather than waiting in the aisle.

The symbolism of the communion rail is quite lovely. The top of the altar rail is seen as an extension of the top of the altar. In other words, when you are at the altar rail, it is a way of symbolically “gathering around the table” of the Lord’s supper. You might even feel the difference too when you receive communion side-by-side with your fellow parishioners.

Historically, people knelt at the rail. However, when we transition to the altar rail *you are not required to kneel*. The U.S. Bishops have said that the norm for receiving communion in our country is standing, but they have also affirmed that any individual Catholic has the right to kneel. Using the communion rail makes it easier for people to exercise that right to kneel, but please feel free to continue to stand as you receive. You will just stand side-by-side at the rail rather than single-file. Also, you do not have to receive communion on the tongue. Whether you receive on the tongue or in the hand is up to you as long as you do it with the proper reverence.

The altar rail is also beneficial for two pragmatic reasons. It is faster than a single-file line because there is less waiting between each person receiving. It is also easier for people to take a moment before and after receiving communion without having to rush to get out of the way for the next person. So, each person has more time to pray even while it is faster for everyone as whole; it’s a win-win.

This transition also means that everyone will go to the center aisle to receive communion. This means that everyone in the far left and far right pews will move through the center pews to get to the center aisle (like we do at daily Mass). This will prevent the traffic backup we get in the side aisles on most weekends.

There will still be one station for communion that is not at the altar rail. This station will be at the middle break in the middle aisle and will be for those in the back half of church. These parishioners can either receive communion there and then go through the middle break to circle back to their pew, or, for those in the back who want to go to the communion rail, they can just walk around that station and all the way up to the communion rail.

Lastly, we want people to approach the rail *as soon as Father receives communion*. If you sit near the front, please do not wait for the priest to get to the rail before you start moving - it is good for you to already be at the rail before I even start walking. Because of this and because we do not want any extra congestion near the rail at the start of communion time, those in the handicapped section will receive communion after everyone else. We will make sure they receive, it will just be after the traffic has cleared out.

It might take a few weeks to get used to it, and we may find a few kinks to work out, but I’m confident that it will start to flow naturally fairly quickly.

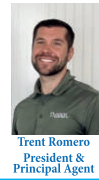
