FROM THE PASTOR: ACCEPTING THE CROSS



When is the right time to accept the cross? I hope some part of you immediately said “always” when you read that question. That answer is not the most practical and helpful one, but it is a good sign if we recognize the general importance of the cross. Jesus said we should take up our cross “daily” and follow him, but life is so rarely reducible to simple platitudes like that. It is true, of course, that we should accept crosses and difficulties and self-denial in some form every day. Where this teaching gets complicated, however, is in recognizing the cross and accepting it.

Jesus’ own example shows him responding to suffering in different ways. Throughout his ministry, Jesus often shows resistance. He deftly outmaneuvers people in arguments, cleverly avoids social and political traps, and on at least one occasion, he even uses his miraculous powers to pay a tax and avoid more trouble. Self-denial is essential. Suffering is unavoidable. Yet, like Jesus, we can and should avoid certain difficulties, solve certain problems, and fight back against some evils.

Even Jesus’ closest friends and disciples do not understand. Despite seeing all the ways Jesus lives a life of sacrifice and self-denial, they are shocked at his most radical embrace of the cross. Jesus avoided political traps dozens of times, so why does he suddenly go silent and just let himself be murdered? Why was he willing to drive money-changers out of the temple and defy the priests one day and then turn around and let those same priests lock him up, lie about him, and turn him over to pagans to be executed? Why fight in one situation but not the other?

I... don’t have the answer. I mean, I kind of do, but not an answer that will make your own decisions super easy. I know Jesus went from fighting back to being executed because it was his Father’s plan. Early on, his “cross” was suffering the difficulty of conflict, arguments, and poverty. At the end, his Cross was the literal piece of wood he was nailed to. In both cases, he obeyed God, not his own human preference.

But what about you and me? We each have many challenges to face. Most of us have at least some people who treat us unfairly. Some of us even have real enemies. When is the “cross” for us a difficult fight and a miraculous perseverance? When is the “cross” for us silently accepting our defeat, knowing God will bring about victory in His own way and His own time? Ultimately, only your conscience can make the judgment of what you should do next. You should pray, ask advice, and study the scriptures and examples of the saints, but no one can truly make the decision for you. Even when the cross takes the form of obeying someone, you are the one who has to choose to obey.

To guide your choice, here are three general rules: First, do not make it about you. When to fight? When something good is at stake that is not your self-image. When to embrace the cross of surrender? When you realize you are fighting to win rather than to love what is good.

The second rule is this: control yourself and your efforts, do not try to control others and results. The third and most obvious rule is this: never sin. If, in order to “win” you have to sin, to defy God or the Church or hurt the innocent, do not. It is better to “lose” like Jesus, to die (literally or metaphorically) than to sin in order to “win” in some particular conflict in your life.

When is the right time to embrace the cross? Always. Just make sure it is the cross and not your ego.
