

Parish Community Center Update

The roof repairs on our **Parish Community Center** are almost completed and just in time for the upcoming **Second Blessings Rummage Sale** and **Alpha Program**.

So many of our ministries' activities take place in this building: The newly revised **PSR Program** will soon begin another year to learn more about their faith and grow closer to Christ. Our **Confirmation Program** will also be starting in the spring to prepare for receiving the Holy Spirit. Events like the **Pasta Dinner**, **Christmas Dinner** and the new **Oktoberfest** will take place here.

The Parish Community Center is also used for fundraisers like the **Spring Extravaganza** and **Bingo**. The **Knights of Columbus Chapter** uses the building to provide our **Pancake Breakfasts** and **Bingo Concessions**. The **Girl Scouts** use the rooms for meeting spaces. We continue to sponsor **AA Meetings** once a week and **Fr. Mehok's Scripture Study** meets here weekly. Our **Men's Prayer Group** meets twice per month to pray together early on Saturday mornings and the **Women in Faith** use it for their book discussions. We also use the building for **Red Cross Blood** drives and other community events.

We lease spaces to other not-for-profit organizations who complement our mission: **Covenant Baptist Church**, a small congregation led by Pastor Christine Smith, has been with us for the past 3 years. They use one classroom for worship on Sunday mornings while they are waiting for a permanent new home. **Rising Star Academy** has been here for nearly three years now leasing four rooms and office space. Rising Star's mission is to transform the lives of children with motor disabilities helping them to be capable, spirited, whole members of the community.

We are pleased to have partnered with these wonderful programs. In opening our doors and sharing our resources we can provide them with the space they need to fulfil their mission. They in turn have provided our parish with financial resources to help supplement the cost of operating our Parish Community Center.
