




## From Our Administrator - Fr. John Betters

Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Feast of the Holy Rosary. While we do not formally celebrate the feast today because it is on a Sunday it is a good day to recognize this beautiful form of prayer that offers us an opportunity to have a focused prayer time reflecting on the mysteries of Jesus' and Mary's lives. I do encourage you to pray the rosary.

This weekend we are implementing a new procedure for the reception of Holy Communion. You will notice several things:



We have shifted the "Communion Stations." This will only affect the center section. All the people sitting in the center sections will come all the way forward to the front of the sanctuary. There will be no ministers in the cross aisle.

The priest (except when it is Fr. Mehok who is unable to distribute) will always be in the center section on the Tabernacle side. There are a number of people who prefer to only receive from a priest and this will allow them do so. If you are one of those people we ask that you sit in this section so it is easy for you to receive from the priest.

The biggest change will be how we help those who are not able to come forward to receive because of age or health reasons to receive. A Host and Cup minister will come to you. Just stay where you are seated. You need not sit in any special section. The Host and Cup minister will first distribute to those in the music ministry then they will work their way through the church to make sure everyone is able to receive. Please watch for them and just raise your hand or wave at them if they do not see you.

They say it takes six weeks to change a habit so I am sure it will take a few weeks for us to make all of this go smoothly but I know we can. After five months of worshiping with you I have come to know you all as a wonderful, joy filled reverent people! We have awesome Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Lectors, Servers, Ushers, Greeters and Music Ministers. They do a wonderful job and are so reverent and help us to have a joy filled sacred Mass. It is an honor to serve with and for you.

We have several "newer" items in the church vestibule to help you grow in knowledge of your faith. We have free books, CD's and materials from Dynamic Catholic that are yours to take and are free (aka Spiritual Wellness Table) now on a rack. We have our Kiosk that has lots of information about events in the parish and surrounding community. Finally we have rack of books, cd's, brochures that are yours to keep for a small donation. All three of these are great opportunities to grow in your faith knowledge and grow closer to Christ in your love and acceptance of him as your Lord and Savior.

This week is the annual Convocation for priests of our Diocese. We will be gathering with Bishop Perez and all of our brother priests to pray together, reflect on our ministry and our call to serve, and spend some fraternal time together. The gathering is from Tuesday evening through Friday morning. Fr. Tim and I will be attending. Fr. Thom has graciously offered to stay at the parish so we can continue to have daily Mass as well as cover for any emergencies and funerals. I ask that you keep the priests in your prayers. This is a difficult time for ALL CATHOLICS, but for priests we face our own failings, sinfulness and that of our brother priests and bishops. We reflect on that, beg God's mercy on us through our genuine repentance and ask his Grace to move forward in the light of Christ.
