## From Our Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Feast of the Baptism of the Lord! Today is the official close of the Christmas season and now we move into Ordinary Time until we start Lent on March 6. Ordinary Time is a beautiful time in which we recognize the ordinary ways in which God calls us every day to serve Him and one another. It was at our Baptism that we were baptized as Priest, Prophet & Kings. It is in that spirit that I would like to propose something for each of us to think about. I would like us think about what role the Lord might be calling you take on to serve our parish at the weekend Masses and funerals.



Our weekend Mass count versus the amount of seating we have would indicate we could only have two Masses each weekend: one on Saturday at 4 pm and one on Sunday in the morning. However, I want to be clear we are not in a position that we need to do this. We have 4 priests available each weekend to cover the three currently scheduled Masses and we are in a good financial position to sustain this. Moreover, we have angelic music that is a wonderful part of Mass. My concern is we do not have enough ministers to help assist us as Greeters, Ushers, Lectors, Altar Servers, and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. We need more people to step up and serve in these roles. The church envisions that we have a full compliment of ministers to assist the priest at Mass. We need people to greet and welcome people, assist them in settling in

to their pew and making sure Mass is ready. We need people to assist the priest in serving at the altar, proclaiming the Word of God and serving Holy Communion. We need to make sure we have enough ministers at each Mass so that we can do Mass well.

We are most in need to Altar Servers. Traditionally these are children but I would like to see if we can get adults to serve as well. We do not have a lot of children in the parish and the ones we do are generally servers already. Altar Servers can be male or female. We need them for weekend Masses and for funerals.

We are also in need of Greeters to welcome people to Mass. We need Ushers to assist people in getting settled and help to take up the collection.

We need Lector's to proclaim the Word of God, the readings at Mass. We need Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion.

Anyone who has been Baptized, receiving First Communion and Confirmation and if married, married in the church and attends Mass regularly is eligible to be considered.

#### Parenting-Part 2 of 2

As I said in 12/30 bulletin, learning to communicate effectively with children is a big part of good parenting. It's difficult to remember that disciplining or praising a 5th grader can be very different than

doing the same with a 7th grader even though they are relatively close in age. I've taught both ages in a school setting and I can tell you that they are very different. Parenting can be overwhelming and I always recommend that both parents and grandparents take at least one parenting class in their lifetime. I thought I knew how to communicate with kids pretty effectively until I took a parenting class and realized I had a long way to go. An example was learning to effectively praise children. It's not enough to say good job! We need to point out exactly what they did right and why it will lead to success in the future. This lesson is an entire class period in my upcoming Common Sense Parenting class! We will never be perfect parents, but we can do our best to prepare them for a life of charity, prayer, and self-discipline if we have the right tools at our disposal.
