- ☐ **Adoration:** Spend a scheduled quiet hour in prayer & reflection before Jesus Christ who is present Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in the Eucharist.
- ☐ **CDA (Catholic Daughters of the Americas):** "Unity and Charity" We come together for fellowship and prayer. We offer opportunities for spiritual growth through Rosary, socials, volunteering, and service projects.
- ☐ **Coffee and Donuts:** Teams on rotation serve coffee, juice, & donuts after 7:30 & 9:00 Masses.
- ☐ **K of C (Knights of Columbus):** Guided by Charity, Unity, Fraternity, and Patriotism; K of C men's organization promotes social and intellectual fellowship among members and their families.
- ☐ **Loving Care:** Serving families after they have lost a loved one by providing meals for the family & friends after funerals & burial services.
- ☐ **Rosary Makers:** Anyone is welcome to join. No experience necessary.
- ☐ **Prayer Shawl Ministry:** Come make shawls to be blessed and given to those in need. No experience necessary.
- ☐ **Faith Studies:** Meeting weekly (Catechism Study, Heart of Mary, Scripture Study)
- ☐ **St. Ann's Society:** The original altar society started in 1869 to support altar care, communion, candle ministry, and promote Catholic life through service.
- ☐ **St. Joseph's Society:** Supporting community in the Catholic faith, while promoting the German tongue.

- ☐ **St. Vincent de Paul:** To find the forgotten, the suffering, or deprived so we can bring them the love of Christ. Often done through financial assistance in times of need. All monies and donations are used for residents of Gillespie County. Volunteer at St. Vincent Thrift Store.
- ☐ **TOOL (Teams of Our Lady):** International lay movement of married couples, designed to enrich marriage spirituality and make good marriages better.
- ☐ **Tour Ministry:** A short guided tour is held after 9am & 11:15am Mass every Sunday. New Guides always welcome.
- ☐ **TMIY (That Man Is You):** Become a man after God's own heart while leading your family toward holiness.
- ☐ **GriefShare:** Support for those suffering grief of any kind.
- ☐ **Faith Formation & Education:** Groups for both Youth and Adults to grow in knowledge of the faith.
- ☐ **Religious Education:** RCIA (Adults), CCD, EDGE (6-8 grade), LIFE TEEN (9-12 grade). We need people willing to help teach.
- ☐ **Altar Servers:** Assist at Masses throughout the week and weekend, weddings, and funerals. Open to 2nd grade-High School after receiving 1st Holy Communion.
- ☐ **Lectors:** Proclaim the Sacred Scriptures at Mass and other liturgies, prior to the reading of the Gospel.
- ☐ **Eucharistic Ministers:** Assist to distribute the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus during Mass.
- ☐ **Homebound:** Serve once a month bringing Holy Communion to homebound parishioners.
- ☐ **Rosary Leaders:** Lead praying of the Rosary before each Mass.



- ☐ **Hospitality:** Serving once a month at Mass by greeting guests, handing out bulletins, ushering, and helping with collections.
- ☐ **Children's Liturgy:** Serve one Sunday a month to gather the children during the Liturgy of the Word at 9am Mass. Scripture, prayers, singing, and discussion are presented for children to understand.
- ☐ **Choir/Musicians/Cantors:** Serving at Mass and other liturgies.
- ☐ **Sacristans:** Prepare the sanctuary, credence table and altar for the celebration of the Mass and other liturgical events.
- ☐ **Environment Ministry:** Help with flowers and linens for the altar.
- ☐ **Office Lunch-Hour Reception (Reserve List):** Be on our reserve list to answer phones and receive walk-ins during the lunch hour so office staff can attend Mass &/or take lunch. Lunch hour is typically very quiet.
