

### **Celebrating Mass with Fr. Bashar**

Last Sunday at Sacred Heart, Fr. Bashar Fawadleh, a priest of the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem and pastor of Christ the Redeemer in Taybeh of the West Bank, celebrated 9:30



Mass. As the parish was celebrating their patronal feast day, Fr. Bashar preached about the Sacred Heart of Jesus and God's undying love for each of us in our suffering and pain.



Later at coffee hour, after shooting some hoops with the kids (see photo at left), Fr. Bashar shared about the living conditions of the people in his parish. Water supply is two days a week, and over 130 checkpoints and gates control entry and

exit to Taybeh. Christian schools accommodate multiple

Muslim families, and, despite the challenges, the people - including Jews, Muslims and Christians - try to live their daily lives as best as they can. Government regulations are many, and the challenges they face are multifaceted.

## Fr. John Sassani Homily Given June 8, 2007 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time **Liturgical Year C**

either for business or vacation. My travel tip is this: be prepared for anything! My shaving kit is stocked with enough equipment to do minor surgery. For a five-day trip, I'll pack seven days' worth of clothes. I amazed myself last summer on a trip to North Dakota to give a retreat to a group of nuns in a convent there. On that eight-day trip, I brought clothes for only four days. I realized that they must have washers and dryers - no need to overstock the suitcase.

In the Gospel today, Jesus is sending the disciples on a business trip - His business - the business of the Kingdom. He gives them His travel tips: take no money, take no clothes, stay with strangers. It's not about traveling light. It's about being *vulnerable*. In sending out His disciples, He wants them to be vulnerable as He is vulnerable - vulnerability for the sake of availability. Christ wants His disciples to be able to announce the Kingdom with personal conviction. The disciples have benefitted from Jesus' personal conviction. Now he wants others to benefit from the disciples' personal convictions. To be sure. His disciples were vulnerable, liable to encounter brigands and bandits, wild animals, hostile audiences, and especially the evil spirit, the enemy that St. Paul is talking about in his letter.

Our obstacles are similar, particularly the enemy. He prevents us from being vulnerable disciples by our own

I suppose we all have travel tips we follow when we travel thoughts, obstacles that he sets for us in our minds. The first one is that faith is a private matter, something that is not up for public discussion. The second is that active discipleship - doing Christ's work - is for 'professional' Christians, priests and sisters and lay ministers. The third is - I have too many doubts and fears to be able to talk about my faith to others.

> Listening to these thoughts keeps people from meeting Christ through us. It prevents the work of Christ from being done as fully as it needs to be done. When we fail to ignore these thoughts - 'faith is private' or 'I'm not equipped to do these things' or 'my faith is not strong enough' - we're carrying too much baggage. We're not traveling light enough. We're not vulnerable either to the grace of Christ or to the needs of our neighbors or to our true selves made in the image of Christ at Baptism.

The Eucharist that we celebrate each week gives us as disciples food for the journey. This is the meal of Christ's vulnerability:

> My Body is for you My Blood is for you Do this in memory of Me

As we come to the Eucharist, let's ask the Lord to help us to be vulnerable so that we can do His work this week for the coming of the Kingdom.



## Religious Education—Registration Is Open!



Registration for 2025-2026: Registration for the 2025-2026 school year has begun! Returning families have had information sent to them by email, and we are so eager to hear from newlyregistering families who will be joining us in the fall. All information can be found online at https://sholnewton.org/

religiouseducation. The registration form is online at https:// forms.office.com/r/M6ZBLz1ew5 or scan the QR code here (this is one common form for all grades and both parishes).

Confirmation Age Change: Please visit https:// sholnewton.org/confirmation-age-change to learn about how we are continuing the transition to Grade 8 Confirmation this year.

For Grades K-5: There are three in-person class options for elementary school students. At Sacred Heart, classes are Tuesdays 4:00-5:00pm. At Our Lady's, classes are Sundays 8:45-9:45am and Mondays 4:00-5:00pm. We also plan to offer one Grade 5 class during our Monday night (7:00-8:00pm) middle school class time at Our Lady's. Classes begin September 21 & 22 at Our Lady's; September 30 at Sacred Heart.

A special note for families with students in early elementary school: preparation for First Penance and First Holy Communion is a two-year program, with both Grade 1 and Grade 2 classes required before First Communion. We also have a Kindergarten class on Sunday mornings, which is an optional but very fun introduction to faith formation classes. Students who attend Catholic School and are entering Grade 2 need to register in the parish, as sacramental preparation takes place in the parish rather than in school.

For Grades 6 & 7: There are two in-person class options for Grade 6 & 7 students. At Sacred Heart, classes are Tuesdays 7:00-8:00pm. At Our Lady's, classes are Mondays 7:00-8:00pm. Classes begin September 23 at Our Lady's; September 30 at Sacred Heart.

For Confirmation Preparation (typically Grades 8 & 9; older grades welcome): Classes are held at Our Lady's on Sunday evenings. Session 1 meets 4:45-5:45pm; Session 2 meets 7:00-8:00pm. The 6pm Mass is celebrated in between. Both sessions will begin on September 21.

Homeschool Option: We are happy to continue offering a homeschool option for those who need it (all grades except sacrament prep). It will again consist of weekly lessons at home, Zoom check-ins with staff, and a family volunteer service component.

Welcome and Welcome Back! We are always eager to hear from any families who may have been away from Mass and/or Religious Education for the last few years—you are so very welcome to come back! And of course we are eager to hear from families who are new to our community. It is always a good time to draw closer to Jesus and His Church—please reach out!

Volunteers: Please consider volunteering as a catechist, assistant, or hall monitor in our Religious Education program. Training and support is available, and there is so much joy to discover in sharing faith!


