

Dear Friends,

"Will cause the greatest harm to those who are especially vulnerable." From USCCB: "Reacting to the passage of the One Big Beautiful Bill Act by the U.S. Congress, Archbishop Timothy P. Broglio, president of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, lamented the great harm the bill will cause to many of the most vulnerable in society. Archbishop Broglio said: 'My brother bishops and I have repeatedly and consistently urged lawmakers to use the budget reconciliation process to help families in need and to change course on aspects of the bill that fail the poor and vulnerable. The final version of the bill includes unconscionable cuts to healthcare and food assistance, tax cuts that increase inequality, immigration provisions that harm families and children, and cuts to programs that protect God's creation. The bill, as passed, will cause the greatest harm to those who are

especially vulnerable in our society. As its provisions go into effect, people will lose access to healthcare and struggle to buy groceries, family members will be separated, and vulnerable communities will be less prepared to cope with environmental impacts of pollution and extreme weather. More must be done to prevent these devastating effects. The Catholic Church's teaching to uphold human dignity and the common good compels us to redouble our efforts and offer concrete help to those who will be in greater need and continue to advocate for legislative efforts that will provide better possibilities in the future for those in need."

Msgr. Dennis Sheehan Homily Given July 11, 2010 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time Liturgical Year C

So – let me ask you: where are we at the end of Jesus' story? "Go and do likewise," Jesus has told us. Is he serious? If we answered every need, if we got involved with every suffering, we'd end up exhausted, much like the robbed and beaten traveler.

Well, look again. Is there a way to be the Samaritan without burning ourselves out? Let's take a look. First, the Samaritan sees the wounded victim. Then, we are told, he is moved with pity. Finally, he does what he can to help.

Consider, for a moment, each of these responses. First, the Samaritan sees. He doesn't glance and then turn away. He doesn't see a hated Jew. He doesn't see someone who took foolish risks and got caught. Instead, he sees another human being. He sees the best and most important aspect of who the man is, not a Jew or fool or undeserving risk taker.

Then, we're told, the Samaritan is moved by pity. It comes from his gut, rises from within his deepest self. The Samaritan here is an image of God, the God who is moved by human pain and sorrow, the God who suffers along with the suffering.

Finally, the Samaritan does what he can. Compassion is costly. Here it cost the Samaritan time, effort, and money.

But back to the question. Am I called to answer every need? No, obviously. But on a regular basis, we are called to see one need at a time, one suffering soul or situation. We're not called to help everybody. We're called to help somebody.

The scene is in New York City on a stormy bitter-cold winter day. It's evening and a well-dressed man is rushing to catch his train. He spies a little girl, painfully thin, too lightly clothed with a sad, desperate, lonely expression. She's alone, probably hungry, certainly cold. He passes by. On the train, he can't banish the image of the girl. He gets angry, then angrier. In a silent cry, he yells to God: "Why don't you do something for her?" Then, as if from nowhere, the voice within speaks to the man: "I did do something for her. I made you."

"Go and do likewise." See. Be moved. Act. By God's grace, we can all be neighbor to someone. For that opportunity today at the altar, let us give thanks to the Lord our God.



Religious Education—Registration Is Open!



Registration for 2025-2026: Registration for the 2025-2026 school year has begun! Returning families have had information sent to them by email, and we are so eager to hear from newlyregistering families who will be joining us in the fall. All information can be found online at https://sholnewton.org/

religiouseducation. The registration form is online at https:// forms.office.com/r/M6ZBLz1ew5 or scan the QR code here (this is one common form for all grades and both parishes).

Confirmation Age Change: Please visit https:// sholnewton.org/confirmation-age-change to learn about how we are continuing the transition to Grade 8 Confirmation this year.

For Grades K-5: There are three in-person class options for elementary school students. At Sacred Heart, classes are Tuesdays 4:00-5:00pm. At Our Lady's, classes are Sundays 8:45-9:45am and Mondays 4:00-5:00pm. We also plan to offer one Grade 5 class during our Monday night (7:00-8:00pm) middle school class time at Our Lady's. Classes begin September 21 & 22 at Our Lady's; September 30 at Sacred Heart.

A special note for families with students in early elementary school: preparation for First Penance and First Holy Communion is a two-year program, with both Grade 1 and Grade 2 classes required before First Communion. We also have a Kindergarten class on Sunday mornings, which is an optional but very fun introduction to faith formation classes. Students who attend Catholic School and are entering Grade 2 need to register in the parish, as sacramental preparation takes place in the parish rather than in school.

For Grades 6 & 7: There are two in-person class options for Grade 6 & 7 students. At Sacred Heart, classes are Tuesdays 7:00-8:00pm. At Our Lady's, classes are Mondays 7:00-8:00pm. Classes begin September 23 at Our Lady's; September 30 at Sacred Heart.

For Confirmation Preparation (typically Grades 8 & 9; older grades welcome): Classes are held at Our Lady's on Sunday evenings. Session 1 meets 4:45-5:45pm; Session 2 meets 7:00-8:00pm. The 6pm Mass is celebrated in between. Both sessions will begin on September 21.

Homeschool Option: We are happy to continue offering a homeschool option for those who need it (all grades except sacrament prep). It will again consist of weekly lessons at home, Zoom check-ins with staff, and a family volunteer service component.

Welcome and Welcome Back! We are always eager to hear from any families who may have been away from Mass and/or Religious Education for the last few years—you are so very welcome to come back! And of course we are eager to hear from families who are new to our community. It is always a good time to draw closer to Jesus and His Church—please reach out!

Volunteers: Please consider volunteering as a catechist, assistant, or hall monitor in our Religious Education program. Training and support is available, and there is so much joy to discover in sharing faith!




