Dear Friends,

Welcome, Benvenuto, Bienvenido, Bienvenue, Bem-vindo, Hoan nghênh, Witaj, Tuloy po kayo, Willkommen, Byenveni. Céad míle fáilte, We are glad you are here! (Happy to add to other languages.)

Pope Leo to Pax Christi USA Assembly: I extend cordial greetings and good wishes to those participating in the semi-annual National Assembly of *Pax Christi USA*, taking place in Detroit, Michigan this July. In the midst of the many challenges facing our world at this time, including widespread armed conflict, division among peoples, and the challenges of forced migration, efforts to promote nonviolence are all the more necessary. We do well to remember that after the violence of the Crucifixion, the risen Christ's first words to the Apostles offered peace, one "that is unarmed and disarming, humble and persevering"). Jesus continues to send his followers into the world to become creators of peace in their daily lives. In parishes, neighborhoods, and especially on the peripheries, it is all the more important for a Church capable of reconciliation to be present and visible). I pray in a particular way that your gathering will inspire all in *Pax Christi USA* to work to make their local communities into "houses of peace" where one learns how to defuse hostility through dialogue, where justice is practiced and forgiveness is

cherished". In this way, you will enable many more people to embrace Saint Paul's invitation to live at peace with their brothers and sisters.

Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

August 15 is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Masses for the Holy Day are as follows:

7:00am - Our Lady's
9:00am - Sacred Heart
12:00pm - Our Lady's
7:00pm - Sacred Heart

This feast commemorates the death of Mary and her bodily assumption into Heaven, before her body could begin to decay—a foretaste of our own bodily resurrection at the end of time. Because it signifies the Blessed Virgin's passing into eternal life, it is the most important of all Marian feasts and is a Holy Day of Obligation.

Both parish offices will be closed, reopening Monday 8/18.

Next weekend on August 16 and 17, Fr. Patrick Hyland, SJ, Grace Davis, and Scott Pyzik will be visiting Sa-

cred Heart and Our Lady's to celebrate Mass with us and share the mission of **Rostro de Cristo**. Rostro de Cristo is an international Catholic mission program founded in 1989 by Fr. Jim Roman, a priest from the Archdiocese of Boston while serving in Ecuador as a missionary. Rostro de Cristo supports and trains young adult professionals (fellows) from the United States who dedicate a year or more to serving Haitian immigrants in Consuelo, Dominican Republic in collaboration with the Missionary Sisters of St. Charles Borromeo. In addition, Rostro de Cristo facilitates week-long mission education programs for high schools, colleges, and parishes.

Fr. Hyland, Grace, and Scott each served with Rostro de Cristo as volunteers. Fr. Hyland is now a Jesuit priest and serves on the Board of Directors. Grace Davis is a campus minister at Boston College, and Scott Pyzik works with a youth mentoring program in Boston. Funds collected in the second collection will support Rostro de Cristo's mission.

Fr. John Sassani
Homily Given on August 12, 2007
19th Sunday in Ordinary Time
Liturgical Year C

I am a fan of Indiana Jones, the legendary archaeologist and adventurer featured in three Spielberg/Lucas films.

In the third movie, Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade, Indy is searching for his kidnapped father and for the Holy Grail – the cup Christ used at the Last Supper. As the plot unfolds, finding the Grail will save his father's life. Indy's quest involves a leap of faith – literally a leap across a wide and deep chasm. Indy makes the leap, and, as he does, there appears a transparent, narrow walkway – not visible, but real – and he is able to cross the chasm. He finds the Grail and saves his father. All is right with the world.

I always think of this film in relation to the text from the Letter to the Hebrews that we hear today. To paraphrase the Scriptures, faith is the assurance of things hoped for and the conviction about things unseen. Hebrews is, to us, a letter, but it was originally a long sermon. The preacher was addressing a weary congregation; they were weary from the journey of faith. The preacher doesn't give them razzle dazzle; he points them to Christ, our forerunner on the journey of faith, the journey that other heroes of faith have walked.

Perhaps your faith gets weary too – I know mine does. There is no razzle dazzle, only Christ. Christ calls us to two things: trust and action. He calls us to trust that he is the bridge on which we can solidly walk over the chasm of life. And he calls us to action – to take the vision of faith and implement it in the various worlds in which we live.

All the other heroes of Hebrews do the same. They are "action heroes", but they are first and foremost "trust heroes". Christ calls us to make him our treasure and give him our hearts.

Let's consider as we come to the Eucharist today all the actions that Christ has done for us and is doing for us even now. He is encouraging us to be his friends. He is inspiring us to see the possibilities of the Kingdom. And he is empowering us to act.

Let's take the leap. Let's trust our hearts to Christ. Let's act by his inspiration and grace, so that we can contribute to the Kingdom and enjoy it when it dawns.

In the margins of this homily, Fr. John wrote: "Blessed are the poor – multiplied bread/ gave his life to save us from death."

Report on Survey about Nuclear Weapons

2025-2026 Sacred Heart and Our Lady's Religious Education



Registration for 2025-2026: Registration for the 2025-2026 school year has begun! Returning families have had information sent to them by email, and we are so eager to hear from newly-registering families who will be joining us in the fall. All information can be found online at <https://sholnewton.org/forms.office.com/r/M6ZBLz1ew5> or scan the QR code here

(this is one common form for all grades and both parishes).

Confirmation Age Change: Please visit <https://sholnewton.org/confirmation-age-change> to learn about how we are continuing the transition to Grade 8 Confirmation this year.

For Grades K-5: There are three in-person class options for elementary school students. At Sacred Heart, classes are Tuesdays 4:00-5:00pm. At Our Lady's, classes are Sundays 8:45-9:45am and Mondays 4:00-5:00pm. We also plan to offer one Grade 5 class during our Monday night (7:00-8:00pm) middle school class time at Our Lady's. Classes begin September 21 & 22 at Our Lady's; September 30 at Sacred Heart.

A special note for families with students in early elementary school: preparation for First Penance and First Holy Communion is a two-year program, with both Grade 1 and Grade 2 classes required before First Communion. We also have a Kindergarten class on Sunday mornings, which is an optional but very fun introduction to faith formation classes. Students who attend Catholic School and are entering Grade 2 need to register in the parish, as sacramental preparation takes place in the parish rather than in school.

For Grades 6 & 7: There are two in-person class options for Grade 6 & 7 students. At Sacred Heart, classes are Tuesdays 7:00-8:00pm. At Our Lady's, classes are Mondays 7:00-8:00pm. Classes begin September 23 at Our Lady's; September 30 at Sacred Heart.

For Confirmation Preparation (typically Grades 8 & 9; older grades welcome): Classes are held at Our Lady's on Sunday evenings. Session 1 meets 4:45-5:45pm; Session 2 meets 7:00-8:00pm. The 6pm Mass is celebrated in between. Both sessions will begin on September 21.

Homeschool Option: We are happy to continue offering a homeschool option for those who need it (all grades except sacrament prep). It will again consist of weekly lessons at home, Zoom check-ins with staff, and a family volunteer service component.

Welcome and Welcome Back! We are always eager to hear from any families who may have been away from Mass and/or Religious Education for the last few years—you are so very welcome to come back! And of course we are eager to hear from families who are new to our community. It is always a good time to draw closer to Jesus and His Church—please reach out!

Volunteers: Please consider volunteering as a catechist, assistant, or hall monitor in our Religious Education program. Training and support is available, and there is so much joy to discover in sharing faith!

Honduras Coffee Returns!

We are happy to share that coffee from our sister parish in San Marcos, Honduras, again will be sold the weekend of September 6-7 after all the Masses at Our Lady's. This excellent, certified organic, and fair trade coffee is shade grown in the mountains around San Marcos.



You may be aware that there is currently a global coffee shortage due to several factors, chief among them climate change and natural disasters in the two largest coffee-producing countries (Brazil and Vietnam). Because of the current high prices of coffee, Dean's Beans, our organic roasting company, has had to raise its rates for roasting, which is a substantial part of the cost of premium coffee. We need to pass on part of this cost hike to our customers, so that the coffee farmers can continue to get a good return for their hard work. Our new price will go up \$1 to be \$13 per pound, still a bargain.

Caring for Altar Linens – Volunteer Needed

This invisible but essential ministry is conducted quietly behind the scenes, primarily in participants' homes.
