Gaza Famine Collection coming. Thanks for your generosity.

"All around the world millions of human beings are starving and dying. Why is it that massive relief from all countries, from everywhere, doesn't pour in from the hands of all those who have an abundance...?"

Where love is, God is. But can God be present where there is no love? Is he absent, then, from nations that kill one another, waging hopeless wars that lead nowhere except to the death of thousands? 'The agony of Christ continues unto the end of the world,' wrote Pascal, the French philosopher. It continues in his Mystical Body. Upcoming Collection for Gaza

Dear friends,

Given the enormous humanitarian crisis unfolding in Gaza, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops is asking dioceses to consider a special collection for relief efforts. Archbishop Henning supports this effort and is requesting that parishes consider taking up a special collection at our parish.

Given the growing immediate needs for food, shelter, and medical needs, Sacred Heart & Our Lady's will hold our collection September 6 & 7.

100% of the funds collected will go to support the work of the Catholic Near East Association (CNEWA) and Catholic Relief Services (CRS). The request concerns their humanitarian work for those suffering the effects of war and famine in Gaza.

The parishes of the Archdiocese have been very generous in recent years when people across the globe and here in the United States are in need. Thank you for supporting our brothers and sisters suffering in Gaza.

Pray & Play Group Resumes 9/3

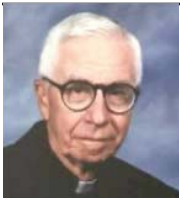

An excerpt from his bulletin column
August 22, 2004

21st Sunday in Ordinary Time—Liturgical Year C

As a parish priest, it is my good fortune to visit many families in their homes. These visits include Communion calls, the celebration of the Sacrament of the Sick, family celebrations and graduations.

It's always a joy to see all the pictures of parents and grandparents, wedding pictures, first graduations and First Communion pictures. These are wonderful ways we remember the happy and sorrowful times a family inevitably has.

I mention this because as a parish family we gather at the Eucharist to remember. So it is good to ask – What do we remember? “God our Father, we celebrate the memory of Christ, your Son. We, your people and your ministers, recall his passion, his resurrection from the dead, and his ascension into glory; and from the many gifts you have given us we offer to you, God of glory and majesty, this holy and perfect sacrifice: the bread of life and the cup of eternal salvation.”

As we continue the Eucharistic Prayer, we ask the Lord to do some remembering – “Remember, Lord,

those who have died and gone before us marked with the sign of faith, especially those for whom we now pray.”

Why do we come together at the Eucharist in the first place? We gather for the Eucharistic sacrifice and Eucharistic communion precisely because the Lord Jesus has commanded that we do what he did at the Last Supper.

As we say in the Third Eucharistic Canon: “And so, Father, we bring you these gifts. We ask you to make them holy by the power of your Spirit, that they may become the body and blood of your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, at whose command we celebrate this Eucharist.”

Remembering at the Eucharist is quite different from the way we do our human memories of our loved ones. A picture in the living room who has died does not make that loved one present to us the way remembering at the Eucharist makes present the very Easter Mystery we recall.

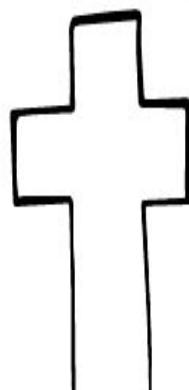

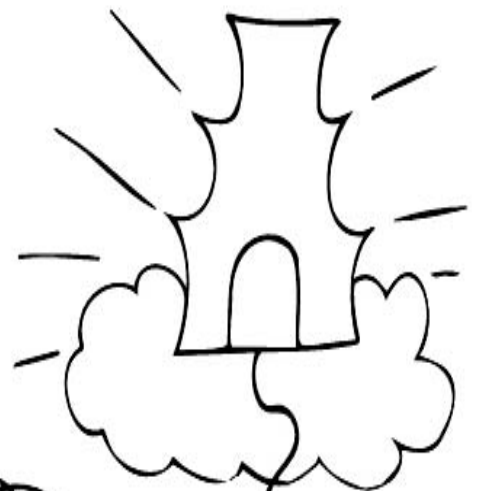
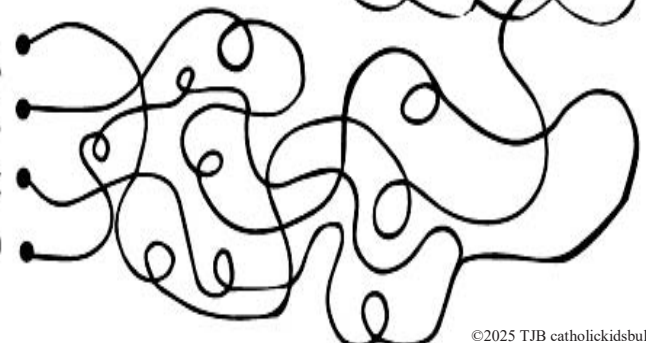

2025-2026 Sacred Heart and Our Lady's Religious Education



Registration for 2025-2026: Registration for the 2025-2026 school year is ongoing. Returning families had information sent to them by email, and we are so eager to hear from newly-registering families who will be joining us in the fall. All information can be found online at <https://sholnewton.org/religiouseducation>.

The registration form is online at <https://forms.office.com/r/M6ZBLz1ew5> or scan the QR code here (this is one common form for all grades and both parishes).

Confirmation Age Change: Please visit <https://sholnewton.org/confirmation-age-change> to learn about how we are continuing the transition to Grade 8 Confirmation this year.

For Grades K-5: There are three in-person class options for elementary school students. At Sacred Heart, classes are Tuesdays 4:00-5:00pm. At Our Lady's, classes are Sundays 8:45-9:45am and Mondays 4:00-5:00pm. We also plan to offer one Grade 5 class during our Monday night (7:00-8:00pm) middle school class time at Our Lady's. Classes begin September 21 & 22 at Our Lady's; September 30 at Sacred Heart.

A special note for families with students in early elementary school: preparation for First Penance and First Holy Communion is a two-year program, with both Grade 1 and Grade 2 classes required before First Communion. We also have a Kindergarten class on Sunday mornings, which is an optional but very fun introduction to faith formation classes. Students who attend Catholic School and are entering Grade 2 need to register in the parish, as sacramental preparation takes place in the parish rather than in school.

For Grades 6 & 7: There are two in-person class options for Grade 6 & 7 students. At Sacred Heart, classes are Tuesdays 7:00-8:00pm. At Our Lady's, classes are Mondays 7:00-8:00pm. Classes begin September 23 at Our Lady's; September 30 at Sacred Heart.

For Confirmation Preparation (typically Grades 8 & 9; older grades welcome): Classes are held at Our Lady's on Sunday evenings. Session 1 meets 4:45-5:45pm; Session 2 meets 7:00-8:00pm. The 6pm Mass is celebrated in between. Both sessions will begin on September 21.

Homeschool Option: We are happy to continue offering a homeschool option for those who need it (all grades except sacrament prep). It will again consist of weekly lessons at home, Zoom check-ins with staff, and a family volunteer service component.

Welcome and Welcome Back! We are always eager to hear from any families who may have been away from Mass and/or Religious Education for the last few years—you are so very welcome to come back! And of course we are eager to hear from families who are new to our community. It is always a good time to draw closer to Jesus and His Church—please reach out!

Volunteers: Please consider volunteering as a catechist, assistant, or hall monitor in our Religious Education program. Training and support is available, and there is so much joy to discover in sharing faith!

Honduras Coffee Returns!



We are happy to share that coffee from our sister parish in San Marcos, Honduras, again will be sold the weekend of September 6-7 after all the Masses at Our Lady's. This excellent, certified organic, and fair trade coffee is shade grown in the mountains around San Marcos.

You may be aware that there is currently a global coffee shortage due to several factors, chief among them climate change and natural disasters in the two largest coffee-producing countries (Brazil and Vietnam). Because of the current high prices of coffee, Dean's Beans, our organic roasting company, has had to raise its rates for roasting, which is a substantial

part of the cost of premium coffee. We need to pass on part of this cost hike to our customers, so that the coffee farmers can continue to get a good return for their hard work. Our new price will go up \$1 to be \$13 per pound, still a bargain.

Caring for Altar Linens – Volunteer Needed

This invisible but essential ministry is conducted quietly behind the scenes, primarily in participants' homes. All linens and towels used at Masses and all other Liturgical celebrations are washed and ironed each week. Volunteers pick up the linens on Monday of the week they are scheduled and return them by the end of the week. Guidelines are provided for the care of the linens. 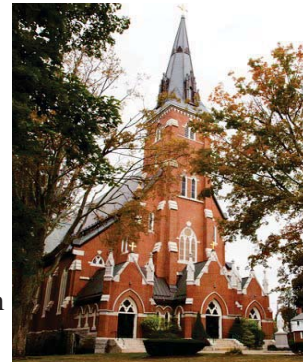

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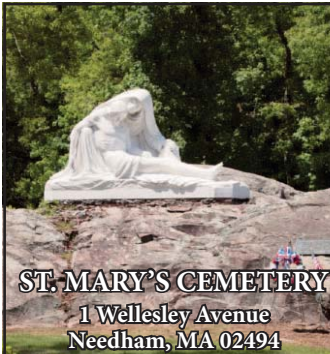
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
