

#### Annual Mission Appeal This Weekend



This weekend, August 16 and 17, Fr. Patrick Hyland, SJ, Grace Davis, and ROSTRO DE CRISTO Scott Pyzik will be visiting Sacred Heart and Our Lady's to celebrate Mass with

us and share the mission of Rostro de Cristo. Rostro de Cristo is an international Catholic mission program founded in 1989 by Fr. Jim Ronan, a priest from the Archdiocese of Boston while serving in Ecuador as a missionary. Rostro de Cristo supports and trains young adult professionals (fellows) from the United States who dedicate a year or more to serving Haitian immigrants in Consuelo, Dominican Republic in collaboration with the Missionary Sisters of St. Charles Borromeo. In addition, Rostro de Cristo facilitates week-long mission education programs for high schools, colleges, and parishes.

Fr. Hyland, Grace, and Scott each served with Rostro de Cristo as volunteers. Fr. Hyland is now a Jesuit priest and serves on the Board of Directors. Grace Davis is a campus minister at Boston College, and Scott Pyzik works with a youth mentoring program in Boston. Funds collected in the second collection will support Rostro de Cristo's mission.

## Msgr. Dennis Sheehan Homily Given on August 19, 2007 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time Liturgical Year C

Wait just a minute Jesus! My life is already a constant rush of chaos, business, fast-forward and non-stop. I come to church looking for a little peace and quiet consolation. I'm looking to center a bit on this Sunday morning. I'm here to get grounded, to find the stable and dependable Jesus.

If that's what you're thinking today, I'm with you. An hour in a nice safe building, the cool of air conditioning, the solace of prayer and good music.

But then there's Jesus today. "I have come to set the earth on fire..." Peace? "No, from me you get division. I'll split up families, divide homes, turn parents against children". Fire!

This, frankly, is the side of Jesus and his Gospel that I dread whenever it comes up. But here it is.... fire!

Fire can be good or bad. But good or bad, you can't ignore it. God knows that. Look at a few places where fire burned in the Scriptures.

Remember Moses and the burning bush? Moses, you recall, was a murderer on the lam from the law. Here he is in the wilderness hoping everyone has forgotten him. But God seeks him out. "Hey Moses, your people need you. I'll set you on fire and you'll set your people free." That's just what God did; he set Moses on fire. Fire can be good, and fire can be bad; but you can't ignore fire.

So Moses takes the people out in the desert. They moan and groan at the hardship. God gives them food. But God comes to them as guide...in a pillar of...you got it...fire!

The Letter to the Hebrews put it this way: "Our God is a consuming fire." A fire. You can love God, you can hate God, but you can't ignore God!

I'm sure the disciples of Jesus just wanted a little peace and security. After Jesus' resurrection, there they were together in the upper room. Maybe their pews were bolted to the floor. Maybe they were going through the familiar, comforting routine of Sabbath prayer. Then the building began to rumble, the doors swung open, and someone from somewhere yelled, "Fire!"

It was fire all right. It was the fire of God's spirit we call Pentecost. It set those sleepy disciples on fire, and they went out to cast the fire of faith on the waiting world. Fire is good, and fire is bad, but it always gets your attention. You can't ignore it.

Jesus comes to us today, looking for a few combustible followers. A real church is like a furnace. It radiates warmth and drives out chill.

What's your choice and mine in the face of all this harsh stuff? "I have come to set the world on fire." Jesus says it's not easy. People probably will react negatively if you become too much of a firebrand. There are those among us who like the cool, stable, and predictable church experience. But then we're very far indeed from the incendiary group Jesus calls us to be.

Imagine a church – here and all around the world – fired up by the Gospel. It would be a glorious sight to behold. Jesus really did come to set the world on fire.

Watch out. You're combustible.

#### Report on Survey about Nuclear Weapons

Pax Christi New England Campaign to Abolish Nuclear Weapons (PCAN) has recently published a report (read it here: <a href="https://tinyurl.com/3cb5mus">https://tinyurl.com/3cb5mus</a>) on its recent survey of North American Catholics for their thoughts about nuclear weapons, 80 years this month after the atomic bombings of Japan. Key findings include that nearly 85% of 900+ respondents see these weapons as an existential threat, and almost half want to abolish them. The report is being sent to the Vatican and shared widely. Registration for 2025-2026: Registration for the 2025-2026 school year has begun! Returning families have had information sent to them by email, and we are so eager to hear from newly-registering families who will be joining us in the fall. **Confirmation Age Change**: Please visit <a href="https://sholnewton.org/confirmation-age-change">https://sholnewton.org/confirmation-age-change</a> to learn about how we are continuing the transition to Grade 8 Confirmation this year.

For Grades K-5: There are three in-person class options for elementary school students. At Sacred Heart, classes are Tuesdays 4:00-5:00pm. At Our Lady's, classes are Sundays 8:45-9:45am and Mondays 4:00-5:00pm. We also plan to offer one Grade 5 class during our Monday night (7:00-8:00pm) middle school class time at Our Lady's. Classes begin September 21 & 22 at Our Lady's; September 30 at Sacred Heart.

A special note for families with students in early elementary school: preparation for First Penance and First Holy Communion is a two-year program, with both Grade 1 and Grade 2 classes required before First Communion. We also have a Kindergarten class on Sunday mornings, which is an optional but very fun introduction to faith formation classes. Students who attend Catholic School and are entering Grade 2 need to register in the parish, as sacramental preparation takes place in the parish rather than in school.

**For Grades 6 & 7:** There are two in-person class options for Grade 6 & 7 students. At Sacred Heart, classes are Tuesdays 7:00-8:00pm. At Our Lady's, classes are Mondays 7:00-8:00pm. Classes begin September 23 at Our Lady's; September 30 at Sacred Heart.

For Confirmation Preparation (typically Grades 8 & 9; older grades welcome): Classes are held at Our Lady's on Sunday evenings. Session 1 meets 4:45-5:45pm; Session 2 meets 7:00-8:00pm. The 6pm Mass is celebrated in between. Both sessions will begin on September 21.

**Homeschool Option**: We are happy to continue offering a homeschool option for those who need it (all grades except sacrament prep). It will again consist of weekly lessons at home, Zoom check-ins with staff, and a family volunteer service component.

Welcome and Welcome Back! We are always eager to hear from any families who may have been away from Mass and/or Religious Education for the last few years—you are so very welcome to come back! And of course we are eager to hear from families who are new to our community. It is always a good time to draw closer to Jesus and His Church—please reach out!

**Volunteers**: Please consider volunteering as a catechist, assistant, or hall monitor in our Religious Education program. Training and support is available, and there is so much joy to discover in sharing faith!

#### **Mass Intention This Weekend**

He began his journey to heaven on Monday, July 21, 2025. How fitting that we remember him on the same weekend we host this year's Mission Appeal! May Fr. Enzo rest in peace.

#### **Honduras Coffee Returns!**



We are happy to share that coffee from our sister parish in San Marcos, Honduras, again will be sold the weekend of September 6-7 after all the Masses at Our Lady's. This excellent, certified organic, and fair trade coffee is shade grown in the mountains around San Marcos.

You may be aware that there is currently a global coffee shortage due to several factors, chief among them climate change and natural disasters in the two largest coffee-producing countries (Brazil and Vietnam). Because of the current high prices of coffee, Dean's Beans, our organic roasting company,

has had to raise its rates for roasting, which is a substantial part of the cost of premium coffee. We need to pass on part of this cost hike to our customers, so that the coffee farmers can continue to get a good return for their hard work. Our new price will go up \$1 to be \$13 per pound, still a bargain.

#### Caring for Altar Linens - Volunteer Needed

This invisible but essential ministry is conducted quietly behind the scenes, primarily in participants' homes. All linens and towels used at Masses and all other Liturgical celebrations are washed and ironed each week. Volunteers pick up the linens on Monday of the week they are scheduled and return them by the end of the week. Guidelines are provided for the care of the linens. Frequency of






