



Golden Jubilee Wedding Mass

The Golden Jubilee Mass is for couples celebrating 50 years of marriage during 2018. This annual Mass, held at the Cathedral, will take place on Sunday, June 3, 2018 at 2:15 PM. Registration is required (through your parish) by May 14, 2018.

First Saturday Devotion

In the Church, the month of May is dedicated to Mary. There are many devotions available to us, but as we celebrate the 101st anniversary of Fatima today (May 13th), we might remember that the "First Saturdays" practice came from Fatima. What is the "First Saturday Devotion?"

On the First Saturday during 5 Consecutive Months, the Devotion consists of:

- 1. Going to Confession
- 2 Receiving the Eucharist
- 3. Saying five decades of the Rosary
- 4. Meditating for 15 minutes on the mysteries of the Rosary

All this offered in REPARATION for the sins of blasphemy and ingratitude committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

The five first Saturdays correspond to the five kinds of offenses and blasphemies committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary. They are:

- 1. Blasphemies against the Immaculate Conception
- 2. Blasphemies against her virginity
- 3. Blasphemies against her divine maternity, at the same time the refusal to accept her as the Mother of all men
- 4. Instilling indifference, scorn, and even hatred towards our Immaculate Mother in the hearts of children
- 5. Direct insults against Her sacred images

Tips for the First Saturday Devotion:


- Confession may be done on days other than the First Saturdays, so long as one receives Our Lord worthily and has the intention of making reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
- Even if one forgets to make the intention, it may be done on the next confession, taking advantage of the first occasion to go to confession. **Need even more help? Just ask a Priest.** On behalf of Christ, he can give you permission so this practice is more doable for you.
- It is not necessary to meditate on ALL mysteries of the Rosary on each First Saturday. In fact, focusing on one mystery for all five decades is a great way to take your thoughts/meditations to a deeper level.



"I've heard My Mother speak of you."


