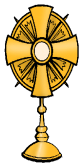

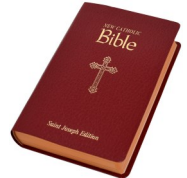

SEVEN DAY PILLAR CANDLES

You can purchase tall pillar candles

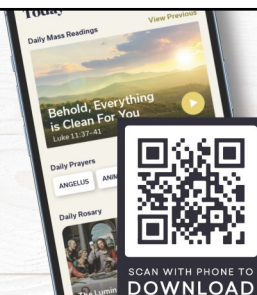
