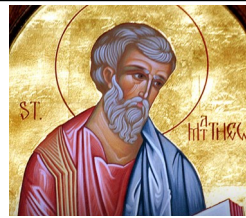

Feast Day: September 21st

St. Matthew the was one of Jesus' twelve apostles, one of the four evangelists, and the writer of the Gospel of Matthew. Before accompanying Jesus during his years of public ministry, Matthew was a tax collector. According to the Gospel, Matthew was working at a collection booth in Capernaum when Jesus came to him and said, "Follow me." Through this simple act of obedience, Matthew became a disciple of Christ. St. Matthew is the patron saint of accountants, actors, bookkeepers, tax collectors, and taxi drivers.
